Application deadline and interviews will be in May, check with the 4-H office for date and times. Please sign up for an interview when you drop off your application, personal story and Member Award Record Book or call for an appointment by application deadline.

- Applicants will be selected based upon their Member Award Record Book, a personal story and an interview.

Your 4-H story (1 or 2 pages) should tell about yourself and why you would like to be 4-H King or Queen at the Kalamazoo County Fair. It may include what your favorite activities are in 4-H, what you have gained by being a 4-H member and personal goals etc.

- The selection committee will be composed of 4-H leaders, Leaders Council member-at-large, Fair Board members and community citizens.
- The minimum age to apply is 15 years old, 4-H age.
- A member can apply for King and Queen unlimited times.
- A member can only be chosen and serve as fair King or Queen once.
- An applicant must interview in person to be considered for King or Queen.
- Members chosen to serve as the Kalamazoo County Fair King and Queen will be notified the following day after interviews.
- The King and Queen will be announced during opening ceremonies and take part in the fair parade.
- The King and Queen will be interviewed by the media and help with fair events.
- The King and Queen must be available for pictures during the 4-H Livestock Auction.
- The King and Queen will receive free fair passes, parking and ride wrist bands.
- The King and Queen will host the 4-H Fall Achievement Awards Program in November.
