# The Eyes Have It

Use the eye that is labeled to help you label the other eye.

a. **eyebrow** \_\_\_\_\_ a. \_\_\_\_\_





1. Color the pupil at the right with a black crayon.
2. Trace around the dotted circle that shows the sphincter (SFINGK-tuhr) muscle. It closes the pupil to keep out light.
3. Trace over the dashed lines that show the dilator (die-LAYT-tuhr) muscle. It opens the pupil to let in light.
4. Color the iris to match yours.
5. Leave the sclera white.
6. Draw eyelashes on both eyelids.
7. Cut out the parts of the eye. Paste them on paper to form an eye.
8. Draw an eyebrow above the eye.
