## Rules and Regulations

1. Spaces are 10'x15' and outlined and numbered, you must stay within these boundaries. You must use designated loading zone areas.
2. The Flea Market will operate from 7am-1pm Tuesday & Wednesday and the Farmers' Market will operate from 7am-1pm Wednesday on specified dates October 13, 2009 through April 28, 2010.
3. Space rental includes three tables (8'x2.5') and two metal folding chairs. You may bring extra tables to use within your space. There are no discounts for multiple booths.
4. Costs: Weekly: 1 Day - \$15, 2 Days - \$20  
\*Monthly: (Nov, Jan, Feb, Apr) 1 Day - \$50, 2 Days - \$65;  
(Dec, Mar) 1 Day - \$60, 2 Days - \$80  
\*Seasonal: (29 weeks) 1 Day - \$305, 2 Days - \$405
5. During scheduled Saturday dates, space rental is \$25 . The Market will operate from 7am-3pm. There are no discounts available for seasonal weekend markets.
6. Spaces may be reserved by emailing [aleldr@kalcounty.com](mailto:aleldr@kalcounty.com) or calling in advance at (269) 383-8761. You must take possession by 8am of the opening day or your reservation will be removed and your booth given to anyone on the waiting list. WEEKDAYS: Payment is due the morning of the market by 10am. \*Monthly and Seasonal payments are due in advance. WEEKENDS: Payment is due by the preceding Friday by 3pm.
7. Signage and advertising will be handled by Expo Center staff. If you would like additional flyers (print or electronic) to distribute, we will provide them to you.
8. Smoking is not allowed inside the buildings, there are designated areas outside for the convenience of those wishing to smoke.
9. Sale of food items is limited to agricultural products, processed foods, baked goods and fresh meats/ eggs; and must comply with all Federal, State and local regulations. Baked goods and processed foods must be prepared in a licensed kitchen. A copy of your license (if required) should be kept at your booth at all times.
10. Sale of firearms, ammunition, explosives, and/or alcoholic beverages is prohibited. The Expo Center staff reserves the right to remove any other inappropriate items from sale at our sole discretion.
11. No pets or live animals are permitted in the market with the exception of tagged service dogs.
12. Concessions will be provided by the Expo Center.
13. Booths must remain setup the entire time. Vendors are not permitted to pack up early.
14. All items not sold must be taken by the sellers at tear-down which is 1-1/2 hours following closing time. Two day renters will be permitted to leave items overnight on Tuesday at their own risk. Expo Center staff will lock and secure the room and close the outside gates at 5pm or after any other event that will be going on.
15. During inclement weather the Market will be closed if Kalamazoo County Government is closed. Tune into local closing listings.
16. These rules and regulations may be modified and/or amended as needed without prior notice.
