



River Oaks Splash Pad Rules & Policies

No lifeguard on duty.

The splash pad is not a supervised area.

Use splash pad at your own risk.

1. In case of emergency – Call 911
2. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
3. Smoking is prohibited.
4. No food or drink allowed on the splash pad.
5. No glass containers allowed in splash pad area.
6. Children under age of 18 shall be accompanied by an adult.
7. Normal hours of operation 10:00am – 8:00pm Memorial Day to Labor Day.
8. No running or rough play. Do not hang or climb on equipment.
9. Patrons engaging in horse play or foul language will be asked to leave.
10. No pets allowed in splash pad area.
11. No bikes, skateboards, inline skates, toys, athletic equipment, balls, water balloons, or inflatable toys allowed in splash pad area.
12. All groups must make advance reservations with Kalamazoo County Parks
13. No objects (lawn chairs, etc) allowed on the splash pad.
14. Failure to follow park rules may result in eviction and/or prosecution.

Any person violating any of the instructions, signs or rules may be evicted from the park.

Group/Organized Use of the Splash Pad Weekdays Only

Organized day camps, churches, daycares, schools, YMCA's, athletic teams, and all other organized groups wishing to use the Splash Pad/Playground must call the Parks Office to register for a date and time. Group reservations are only available Monday through Friday. There are two time slots available: 10:00am-1:00pm or 1:00pm-4:00pm. No more than two organized groups are permitted to use the Splash Pad at the same time.

Groups coming by bus or large van (8+ passengers) are required to pay the \$2.00 per person park admission fee. Personal vehicle admission is \$5.00 per vehicle.

Groups of 25 people or less are required to reserve a date and time slot. This reservation does not permit usage of any of the picnic shelters.

Groups of 26 to 75 are required to rent one of the picnic shelters (Oak Grove, Morrow Lake or Soccer Shelter). They must also limit the number of people in the Splash Pad/Playground area at any one time to no more than 25 members of their group.

Groups may not rent more than one time slot in any given two week period.

There is no bus parking in the splash pad parking lots. Groups will be assisted with locations for bus parking when they make their reservation.

Groups that have not made a reservation will be given a warning and may be asked to leave by Park Staff if the splash pad cannot accommodate the group. If a group arrives a second time without a reservation they will be asked to leave immediately.
