The County Board of Commissioners adopted the Articles of Incorporation for the Central County Transportation Authority (CCTA) at the meeting of August 6, 2014. The Articles of Incorporation state the following regarding the appointment of the Board:

Appointment. The County appoints each of the directors. If the County receives a recommendation before the County makes the appointment, then the County will give great weight to that recommendation and may disregard that recommendation only for good cause. Recommendations may be made as follows:

Definitions. For purposes of this section, “rural” means an area outside the Authority’s district and “urban” means an area inside the Authority’s district.

Comstock Township

This position is currently held by Comstock Supervisor Ann Nieuwenhuis. The Comstock Township Board, at their meeting held on September 21, 2015, voted to recommend the reappointment of Mrs. Nieuwenhuis. Request for reappointment from Comstock Township is attached. The term will be for three-years and expire September of 2018.

City of Kalamazoo

This position is currently held by Greg Rosine. The Kalamazoo City Commission, at their meeting of October 5, 2015, voted to recommend the reappointment of Mr. Rosine. Request for reappointment from the City of Kalamazoo is attached. Mr. Rosine currently serves as the CCTA Vice-Chair and he is also on the KCTA Board. The term will be for three-years and expire September of 2018.

CENTRAL COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (CCTA)

The Central County Transportation Authority was created in August 2014 as part of the goal to regionalize public transit. The CCTA is to plan, promote, finance, acquire, improve, enlarge, extend, own, construct, operate, maintain, replace, and contract for public transit services in Kalamazoo County including fixed-route bus within the boundaries of the Authority which include the cities of Kalamazoo, Parchment and Portage and Townships of Comstock, Kalamazoo and part of Oshtemo(voting precincts 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8). 



My name is Jason Meddaugh and I am writing to apply for a position on the new Central County Transportation Authority Board. Some of you may remember me as an interview finalist this past December.


