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FOCUS ON: Mammogram Screening

The screening test for breast cancer is the bilateral screening mammogram. As you know, women age 40-64 may enroll in BCCCNP, and our program has always recommended that breast cancer screening begin at age 40.

Upon reviewing data statewide, the number of women with normal CBE's who subsequently receive a screening mammogram has declined. Please help us ensure that clients coming to our BCCCN Program are receiving their annual mammogram screening.

Adequate and improving breast cancer screening rates are a component of our accreditation moving forward. We will continue to send our "request notes" monthly, and we may "bug" you a little more often, to make sure clients are following through with their mammogram testing. Medicaid through BCCCNP

BCCCNP-eligible women with a NEW breast or cervical cancer diagnosis may apply for straight Medicaid through BCCCNP. This will reduce patient costs during treatment.

NEW – Clients with breast or cervical cancer, enrolled in Michigan’s Healthy Michigan Plan (HMP) or another type of Medicaid: ARE eligible to transfer to BCCCNP MTA at any point during their cancer treatment.

Wrap-Around Grant updates



Our current Wrap-Around Grant funded by Susan G. Komen Michigan is available until March 31, 2017.

This funding covers breast services for women of all ages, though our primary focus is on women under 40 years of age, and Men.

Women and Men must meet the same eligibility guidelines as the BCCCNP (income, no/inadequate insurance). Funds are available for breast screening and/or diagnostic testing.

These additional funds have allowed us to serve 33 women in need of breast screening and/or diagnostic services and who were not able to enroll into BCCCNP.
