The Kalamazoo County Veterans Day Ceremony will be held at Rose Park Veterans Memorial (East Michigan Avenue at Kings Highway). *This year's program is a remembrance of the veterans of World War I and falls on the 100th anniversary of the armistice that ended that terrible war.* Participants include honor guards from the United States Marine Corps and the Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Office. The program includes excellent speakers, music and poetry.

This year's guest speakers are Tom Deitz, former curator of the Kalamazoo Valley Museum and an expert on Kalamazoo history; Steve Rossio, of the Portage Public Library who will present a program about a Kalamazoo medic in WWI, and Col. Bryan Teff, Commander of the 110th Attack Wing, Michigan Air National Guard based in Battle Creek, and a veteran of Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom, having deployed seven times to southwest Asia. Music will be provided by Scott Thornburg, Grace Kalafut, and the Kalamazoo Area Pipers.
