**Proposal to Offset Millage Rollback of County Operating Tax Levy**

Shall the voted allocated Kalamazoo County millage rate of 4.85 mills (\$4.85 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 4.6318 mills (\$4.6318 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased by up to 0.2182 mills (\$0.2182 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to the 1966 original allocated rate to recover that millage reduction and be levied by Kalamazoo County for twenty (20) years (2023-2042 inclusive), for general operating purposes.

If approved and levied in full, this Millage will raise an estimated additional \$2,181,045.00 for general County operating purposes in the first calendar year of the levy based on state taxable valuation.

**Local School District**

**Lawton Community Schools  
Operating Millage Proposal**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its full revenue per pupil foundation allowance and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Lawton Community Schools, Van Buren and Kalamazoo Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 17.7073 mills (\$17.7073 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 3 years, 2024, 2025 and 2026, and also be increased by .5 mill (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2023 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and if .2927 mill of the above is levied in 2023 is approximately \$22,004, and if 18 mills of the above are levied in 2024 is approximately \$1,340,000 (this millage is to renew millage that will expire with the 2023 levy and to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore that reduction)?

**Plainwell Community Schools  
Operating Millage Proposal**

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Plainwell Community Schools, Allegan, Kalamazoo and Barry Counties, Michigan, be increased by 3 mills (\$3.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2022 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2022 is approximately \$139,000 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore that reduction)?

**Lawrence Memorial District Library  
Library Millage Proposal**

Shall the Lawrence Memorial District Library, Counties of Kalamazoo and Calhoun, Michigan, be authorized to levy annually a new additional millage in an amount not to exceed .74 mill (\$0.74 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the Lawrence Memorial District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2022 to 2031, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Lawrence Memorial District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Lawrence Memorial District Library in the first year (2022) is approximately \$79,000.
