

ATTENTION CANDIDATES FOR COUNTY OFFICE

Candidates for the August primary must still file by Tuesday, April 21 at 4:00 pm. Those filing for township offices must file with the township clerk; contact that office for available hours.

The following candidates file with the County Clerk:

- State Representative – 61st District
- Countywide Offices
 - Prosecuting Attorney
 - Sheriff
 - Clerk/Register
 - Treasurer

Candidates are encouraged to file by mail using the [affidavit of identity form](#). Mail the [notarized](#) form with a check for the \$100 filing fee made out to Kalamazoo County Clerk. It must be received no later than 4:00 pm on Tuesday, April 21.

County Clerk staff will be available by appointment on Tuesday, April 21 from 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. to receive candidate filings in person. Appointments can be made by e-mailing Elections@kalamazoo.org. Social distancing orders will be observed.

Precinct Delegate Affidavits [form](#) must be filed with the County Clerk no later than 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 5. Again, e-Notarization is permitted and the completed forms can be e-mailed to: elections@kalamazoo.org, as well as mailed.
