

NOTICE OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT there will be a review of apportionment for the Sunset Lake Level District (Drain No 318) on Monday August 5, 2013 at the Office of Kalamazoo County Drain Commissioner, 201 West Kalamazoo Ave, Kalamazoo, MI 49007 in Room 105, between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. as required by MCL 324.30701 et seq. Inland Lake Levels, Part 307 PA 451 of 1994. The Sunset Lake Level District is comprised of all properties and back properties adjacent to Sunset Lake, located in the Village of Vicksburg and the townships of Brady and Schoolcraft, in Kalamazoo County. At large assessments will also be paid by the County of Kalamazoo, the townships of Brady and Schoolcraft, and the Village of Vicksburg. Special assessments under this part shall be spread upon the county tax rolls, and shall be subject to the same interest and penalty charges and shall be collected in the same manner as county taxes.

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES needing Accommodations for effective participation in the meeting should contact the County Drain Commissioner at the number below or through the Michigan Relay Center at 1-800-649-3777 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

PURSUANT TO SECTION 14 of MCL 324.30701 et seq. Inland Lake Levels, Part 307 PA 451 of 1994, any owner of land within the District or any city, village, township or county feeling aggrieved by the apportionment of benefits may appeal the apportionment in court within 15 days after the day of Review of Apportionment.

THIS ASSESSMENT IS FOR: cost of laying out and designing a district for a legal lake level, including district survey; surveying, establishing and recording the easement for the dam; tree removal; legal lake study; dam inspection; publishing costs' probate judges fees; and routine operations. It is helpful if you bring the notice you receive in the mail showing your parcel number and assessment amount.
