Households that received Michigan Department of Health and Human Services cash assistance (FIP), State Disability Assistance (SDA), or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) in the last 12 months are automatically income-eligible for services

*Homeowners and renters (w/ landlord permission) may apply for this program.

Energy-saving measures performed typically include weatherstripping and caulking, insulating walls and ceilings, repairing or replacing heating systems, switching to efficient lights, and cost-effective measures following state and federal guidelines. The program also evaluates participating homes for potential natural gas and carbon monoxide threats from combustion appliances. The program does not typically provide aesthetic measures such as painting or installing new windows.

HOME REPAIR FOR OLDER ADULTS

Senior Services Home Repair program provides vital in-home support to seniors with housing concerns. Emergency assistance with electrical, plumbing and carpentry repairs, as well as barrier free modifications, help seniors to stay safely and securely in their own homes. Cost-share and other sources help fund the program. Ability to provide this assistance may vary based on availability of funds in specific areas. Home repair estimate fee is \$ 25 (unless covered by a grant). The Tuesday Toolmen volunteers, under the direction of licensed staff, provide minor home repairs and modifications (such as installing grab bars for safety) to senior homeowners.

Home repair services provided by licensed repair staff, including Ramp Construction, Chore Services and Home Safety Repair, for anyone 60 years old or more, at or below 200% of poverty, with priority to the most at-risk and vulnerable senior population.

A fee-for-service option is available to the general public.

The CDBG Program provides Housing Assistance Programs to income-eligible homeowners, including:

Housing Rehabilitation Program: Deferred loans up to \$20,000 per housing unit are available in the form of a no interest, deferred loan for home improvements and repairs.

Emergency Repair Grant Program: Up to \$1,000 in grant funds to complete household repairs that pose an immediate threat to the health, safety and welfare of the residents.

Down Payment Assistance Program: Deferred loans up to \$3,000 with no interest charges are available to assist with up to 50% of the required down payment and eligible closing costs for the purchase and occupancy of a home within Portage city limits.
