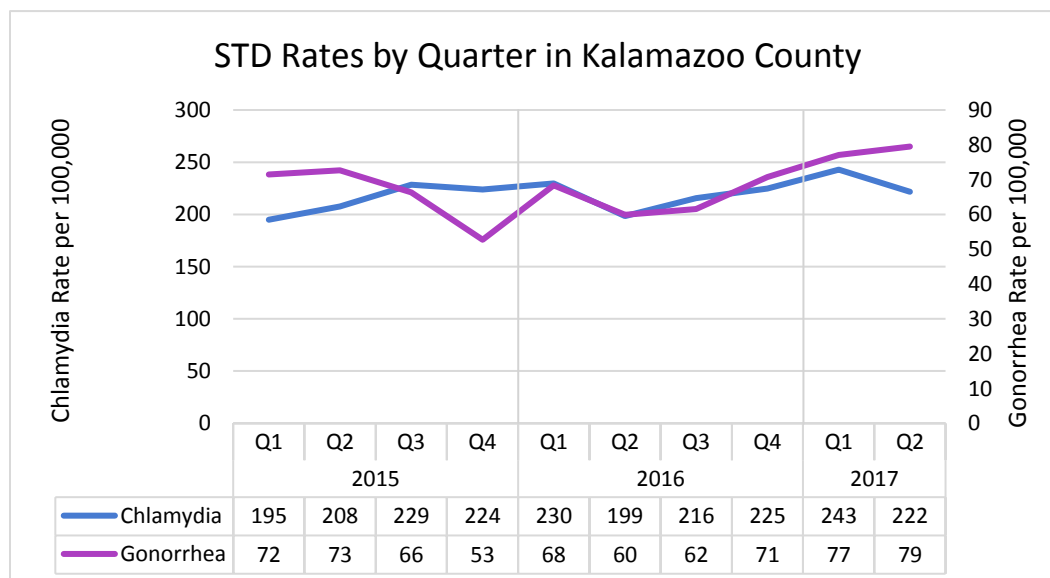

## Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Quarterly Report Second Quarter 2017

### Quick Facts:

- Chlamydia is up 12% over second quarter 2016, but down 9% from first quarter 2017
- Chlamydia rates are higher in females, African Americans, and persons who are 15-24 years of age
- Gonorrhea is up 33% compared to second quarter 2016 and 3% up from first quarter 2017
- Gonorrhea rates are higher in males, African Americans, and persons 15-29 years of age

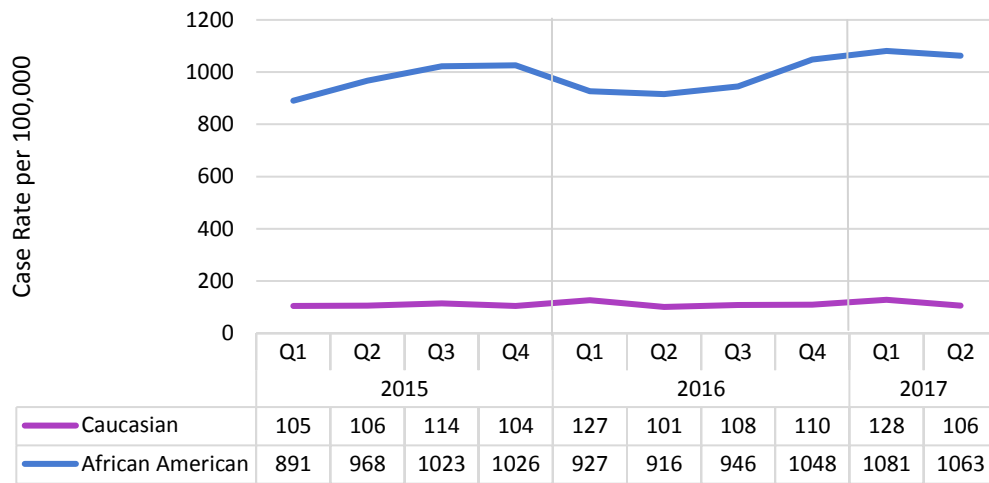

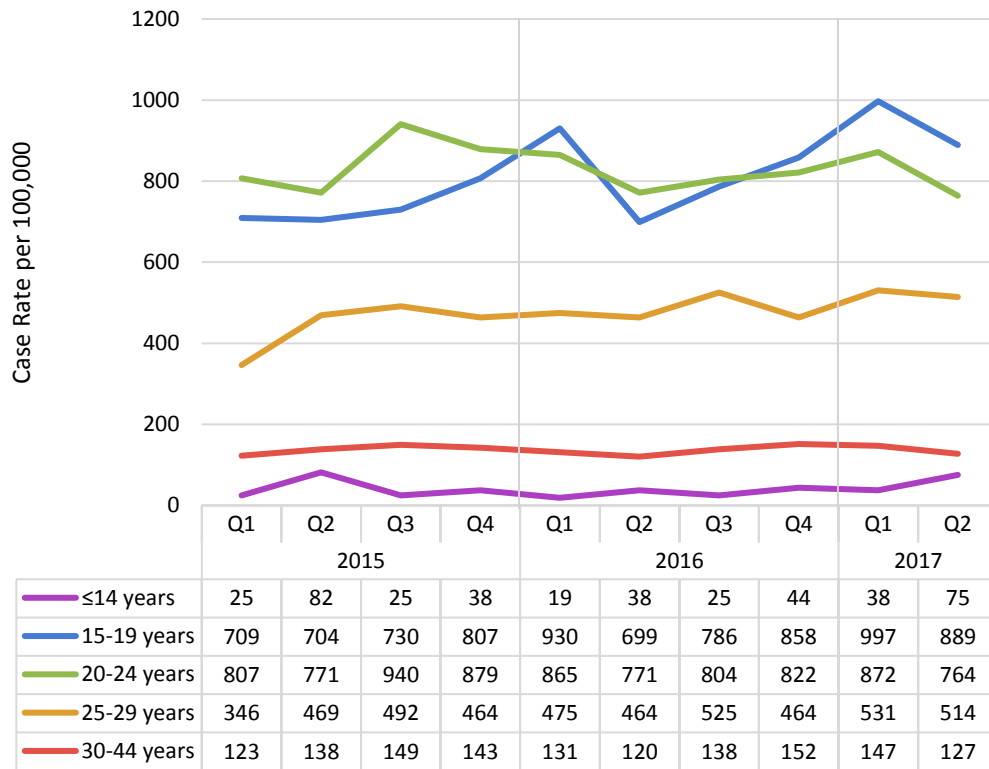

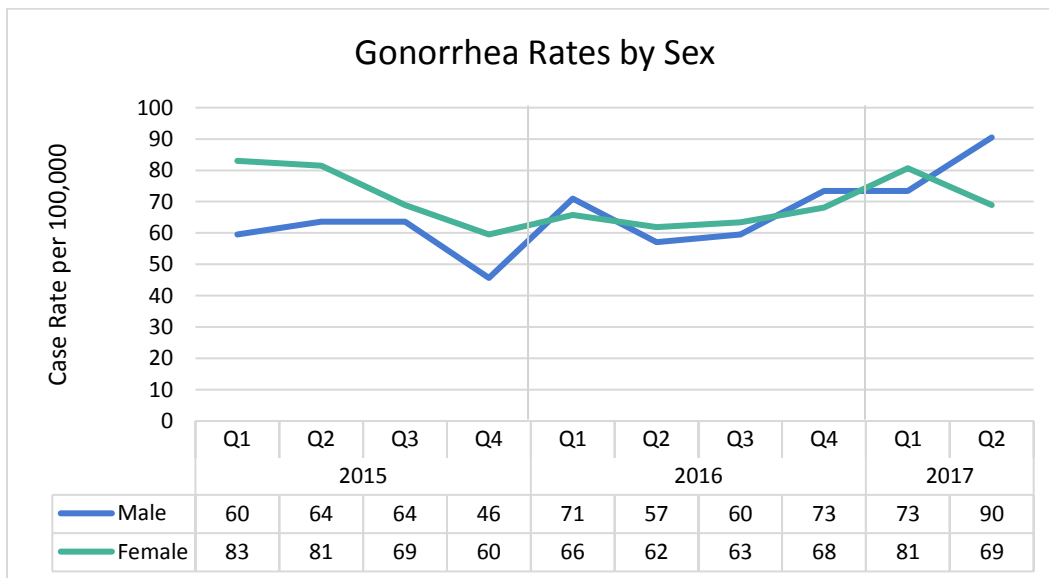
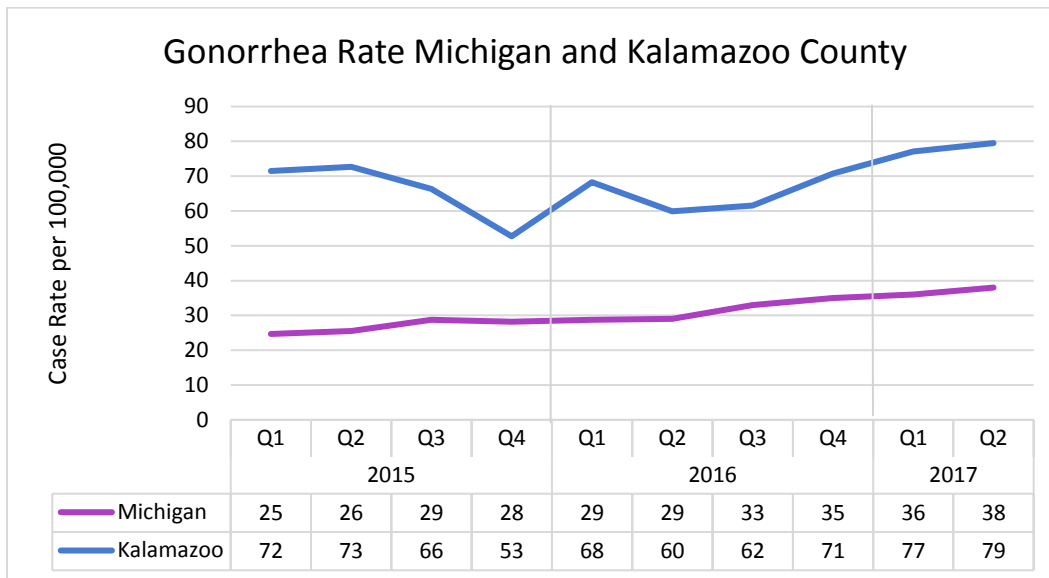
### Chlamydia Rate by Race

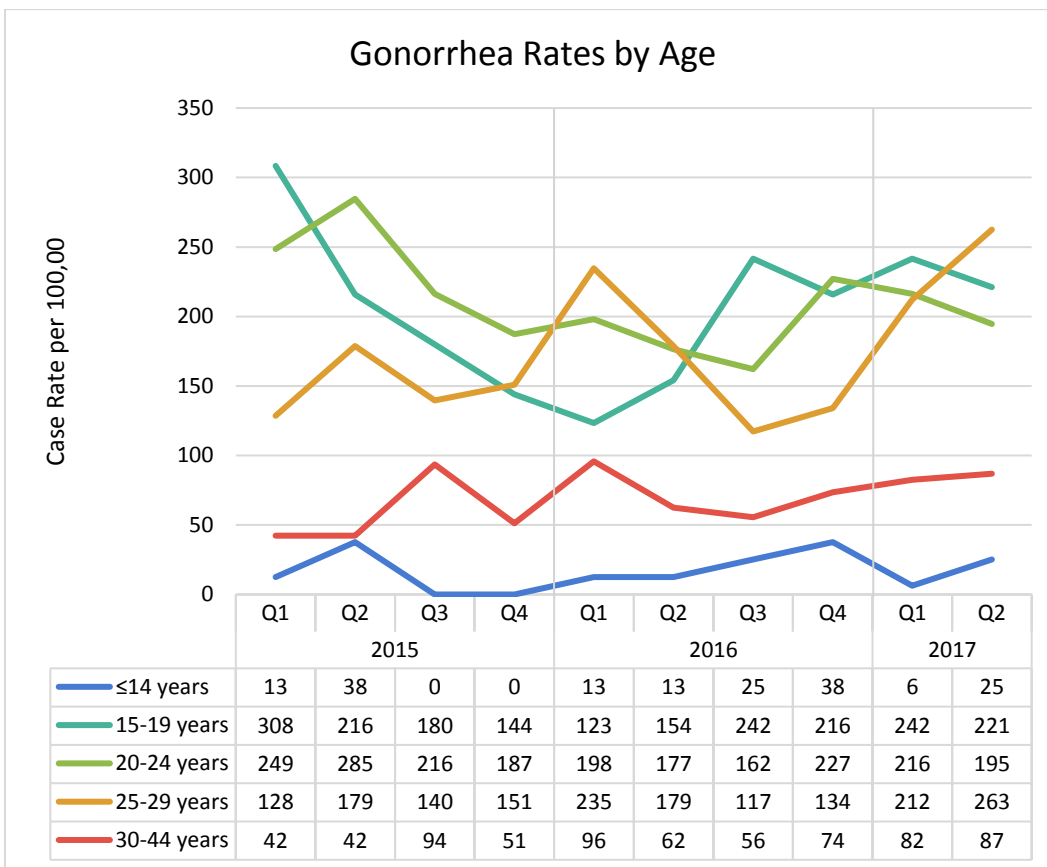
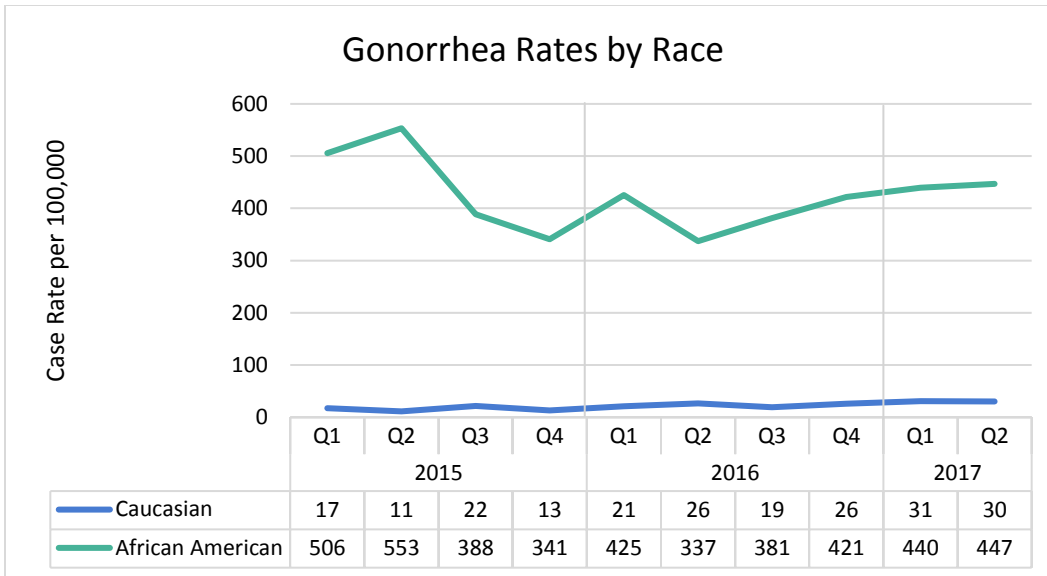


### Chlamydia Rate by Age
