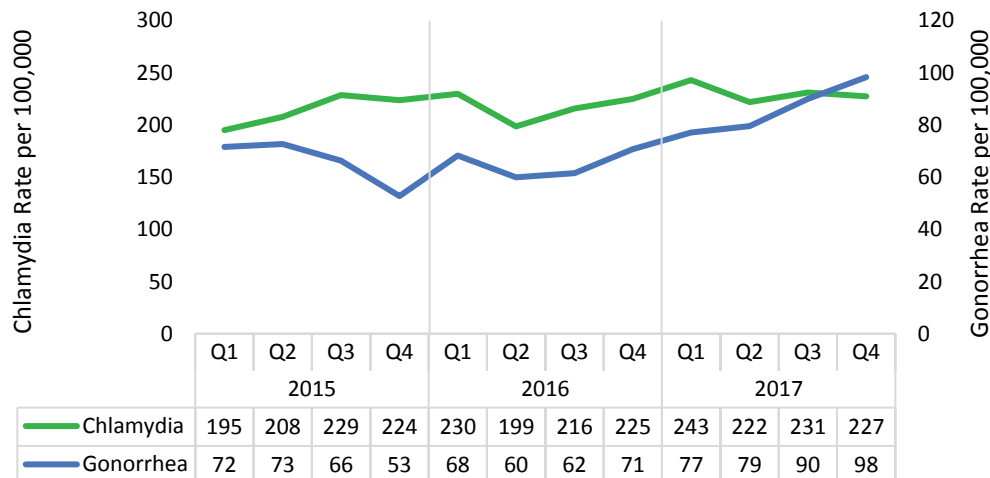
Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Quarterly Report Fourth Quarter 2017

Quick Facts:

- Chlamydia increased 1% over 4th quarter 2016 and decreased 1.6% from 3rd quarter 2017
- Chlamydia **increased 6%** in 2017 compared to 2016
- Chlamydia rates are higher in females, African Americans, and persons who are 15-24 years of age
- Gonorrhea increased 39% compared to 4th quarter 2016 and increased 9% from 3rd quarter 2017
- Gonorrhea **increased 32%** in 2017 compared to 2016
- Gonorrhea rates are higher in African Americans and persons 15-29 years of age

STD Rates by Quarter in Kalamazoo County



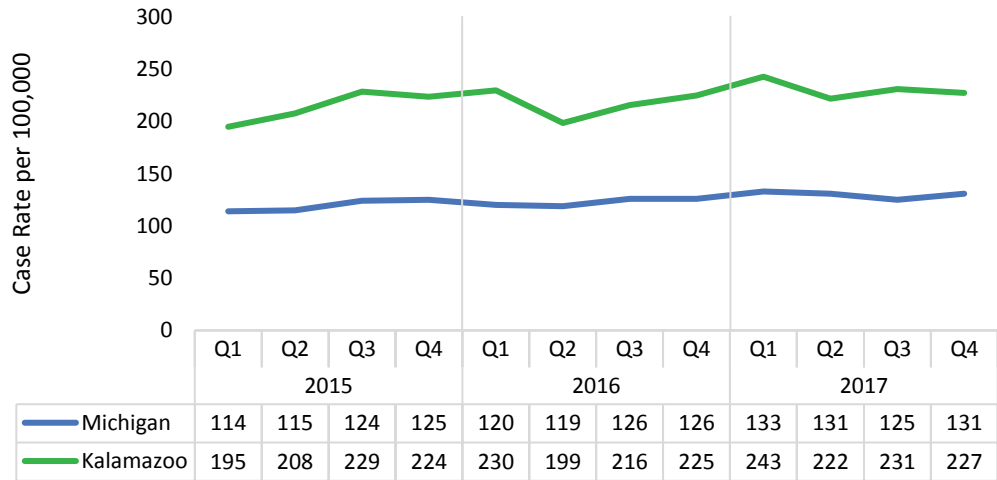

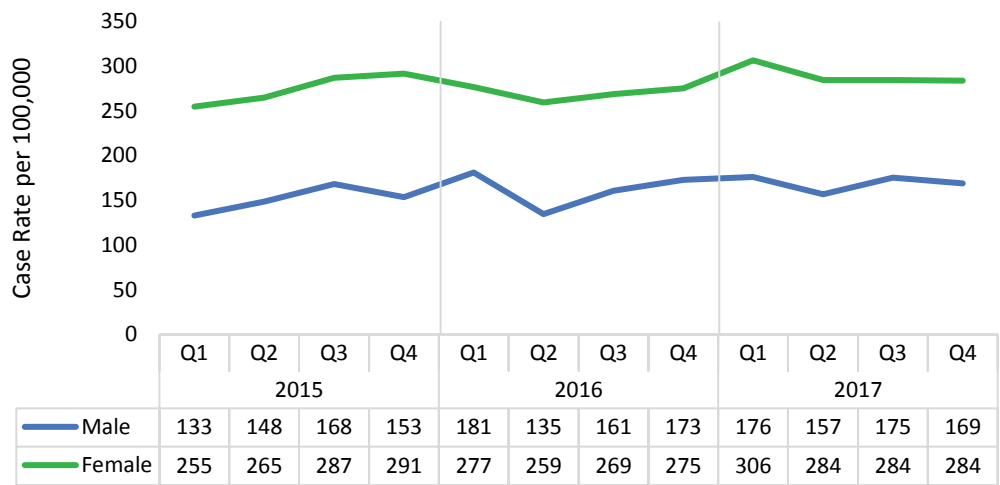

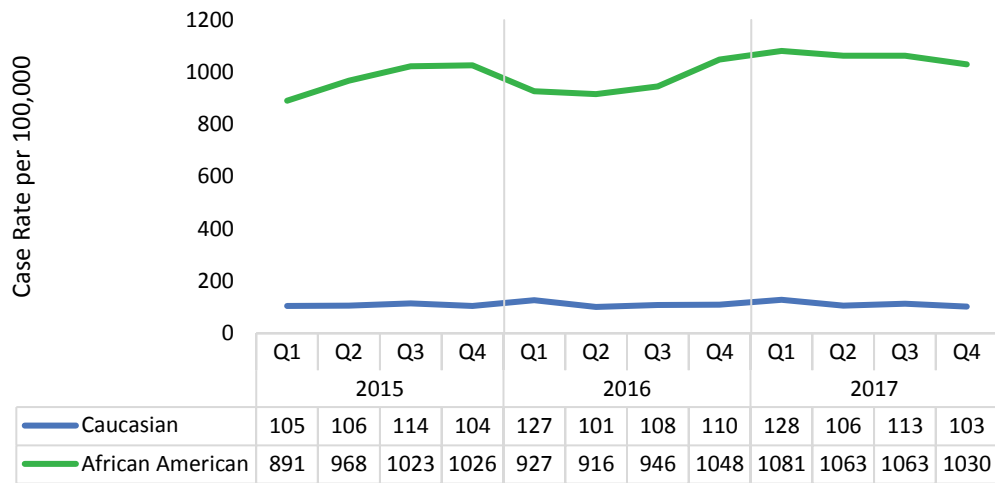
Chlamydia Rate in Michigan and Kalamazoo County



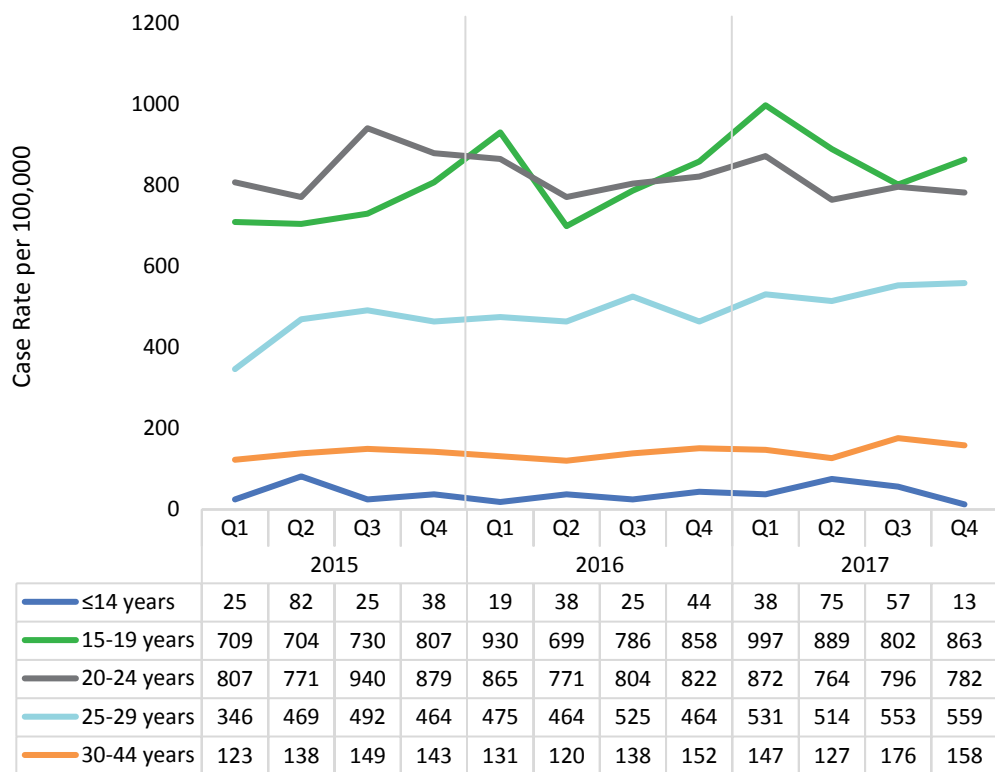
Chlamydia Rate by Sex



Chlamydia Rate by Race

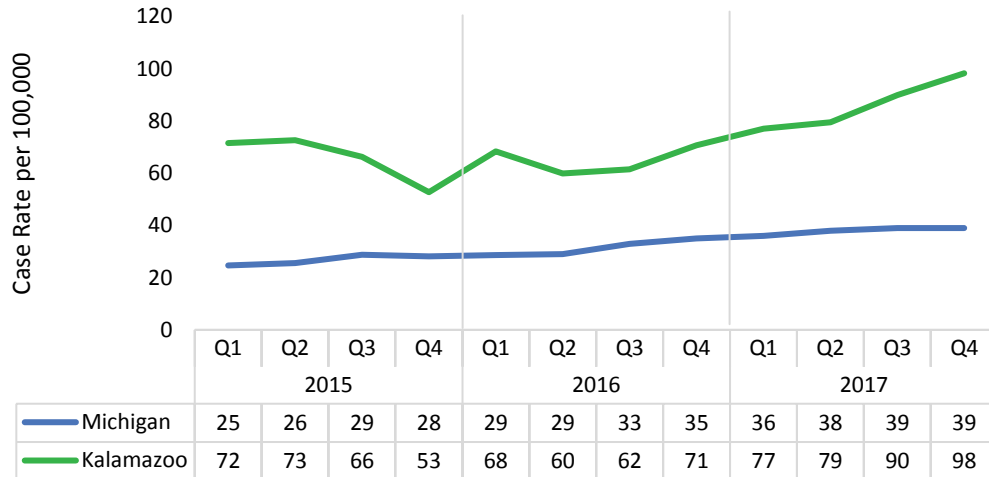


Chlamydia Rate by Age

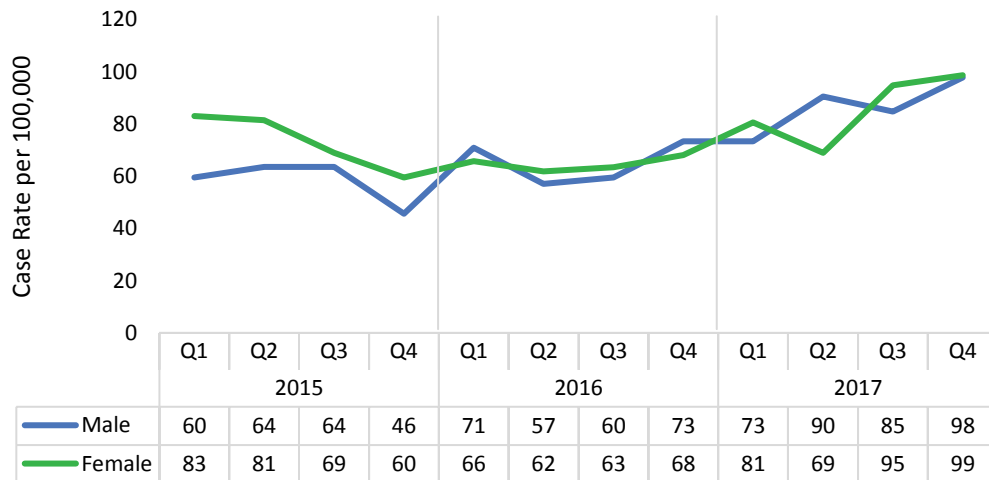

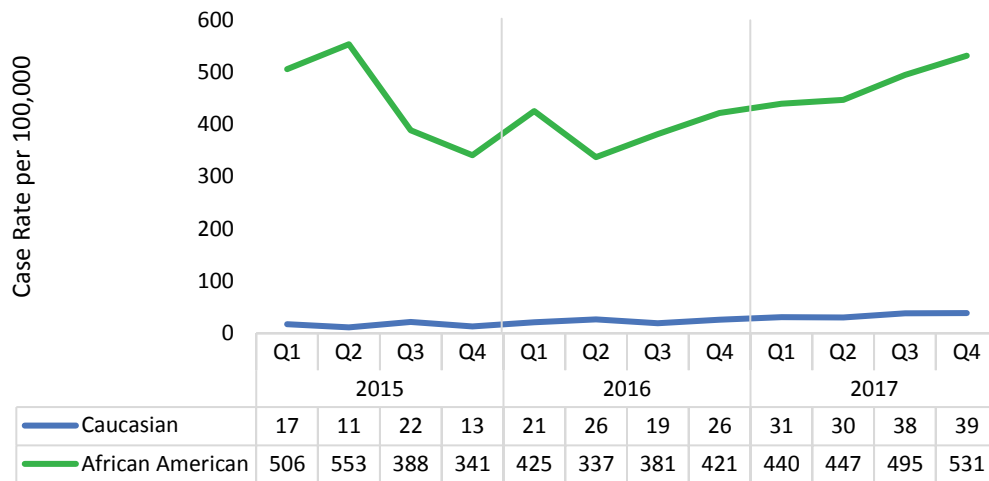
Gonorrhea Rate Michigan and Kalamazoo County



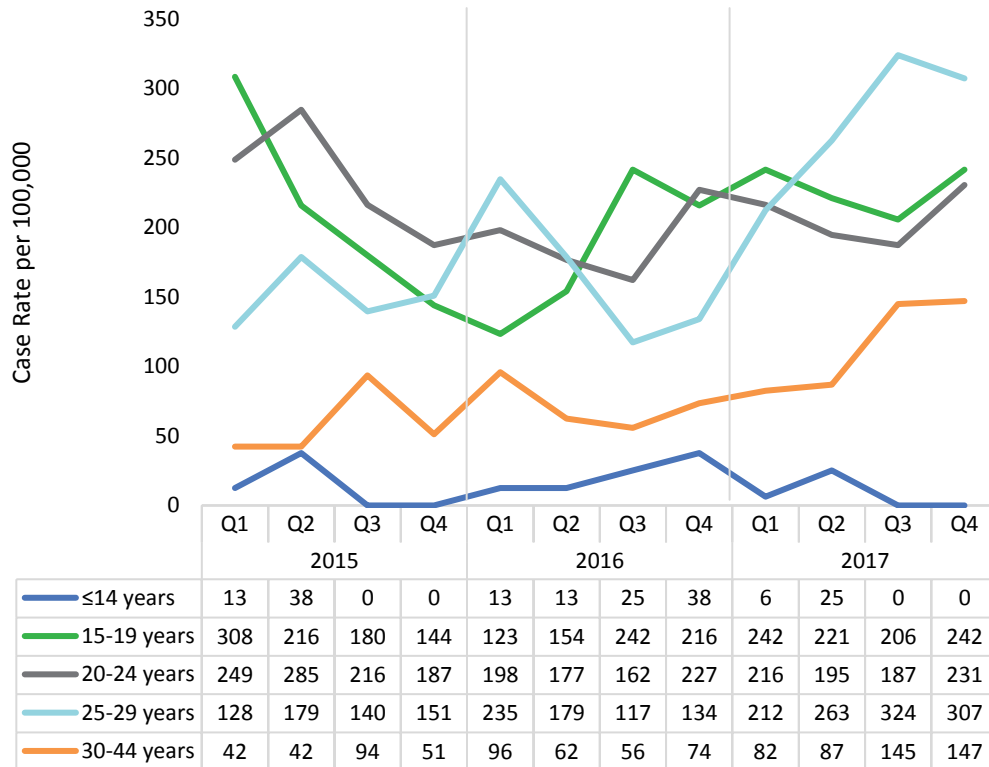
Gonorrhea Rates by Sex
