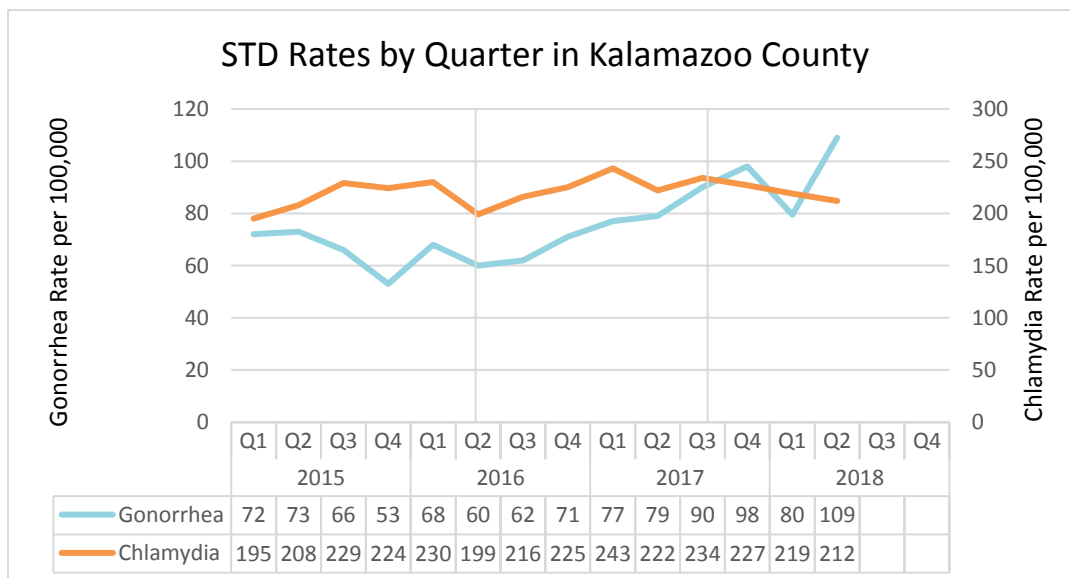

Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Quarterly Report Second Quarter 2018

Quick Facts:

- Chlamydia decreased 4% compared to 2nd quarter 2017 and decreased 3% from 1st quarter 2018
- Chlamydia rates are higher in females, African Americans and Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders, and persons who are 15-24 years of age
- Gonorrhea increased 38% compared to 2nd quarter 2017 and increased 38% from 1st quarter 2018
- Gonorrhea rates are higher in African Americans and persons 15-29 years of age

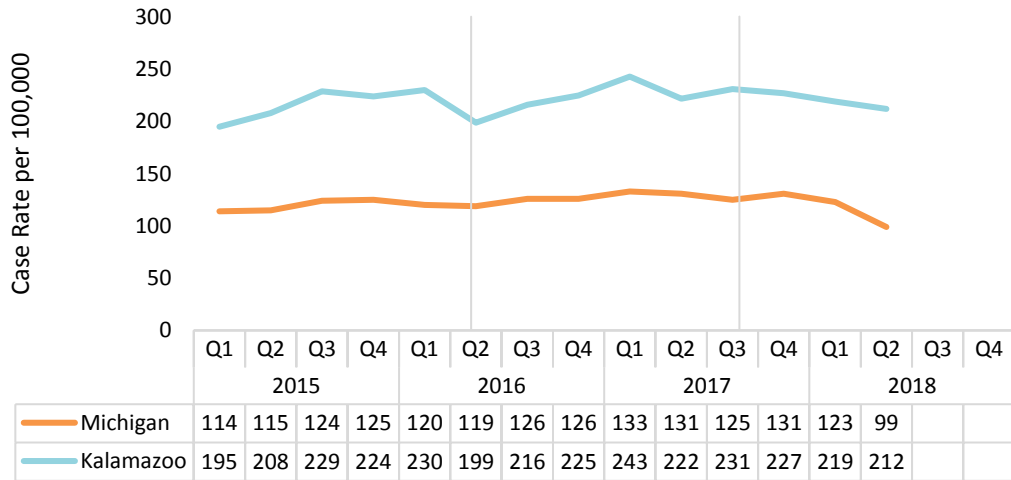

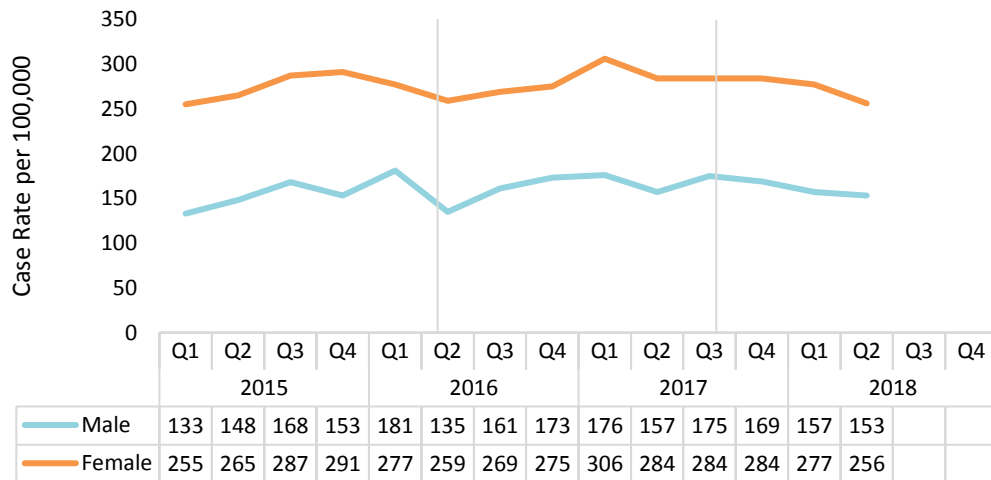

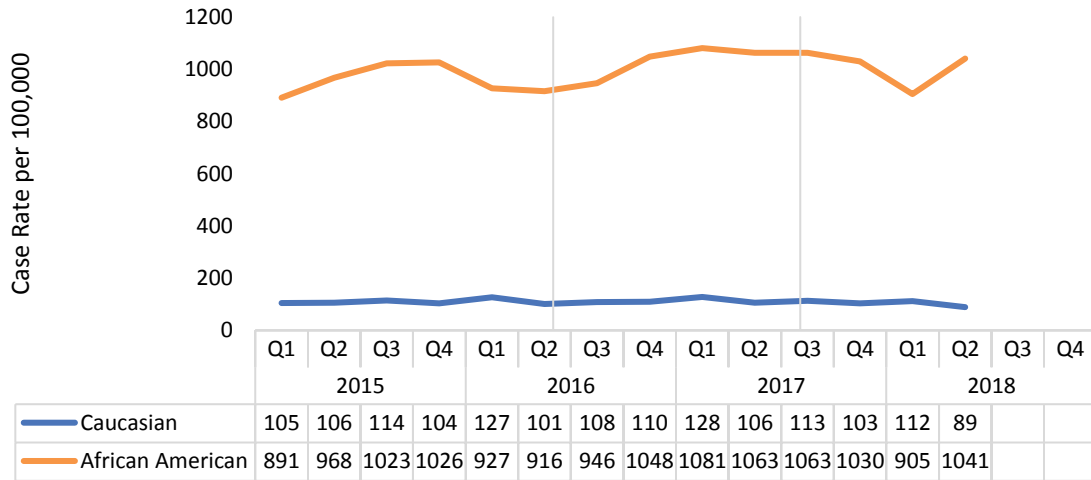
Chlamydia Rate in Michigan and Kalamazoo County



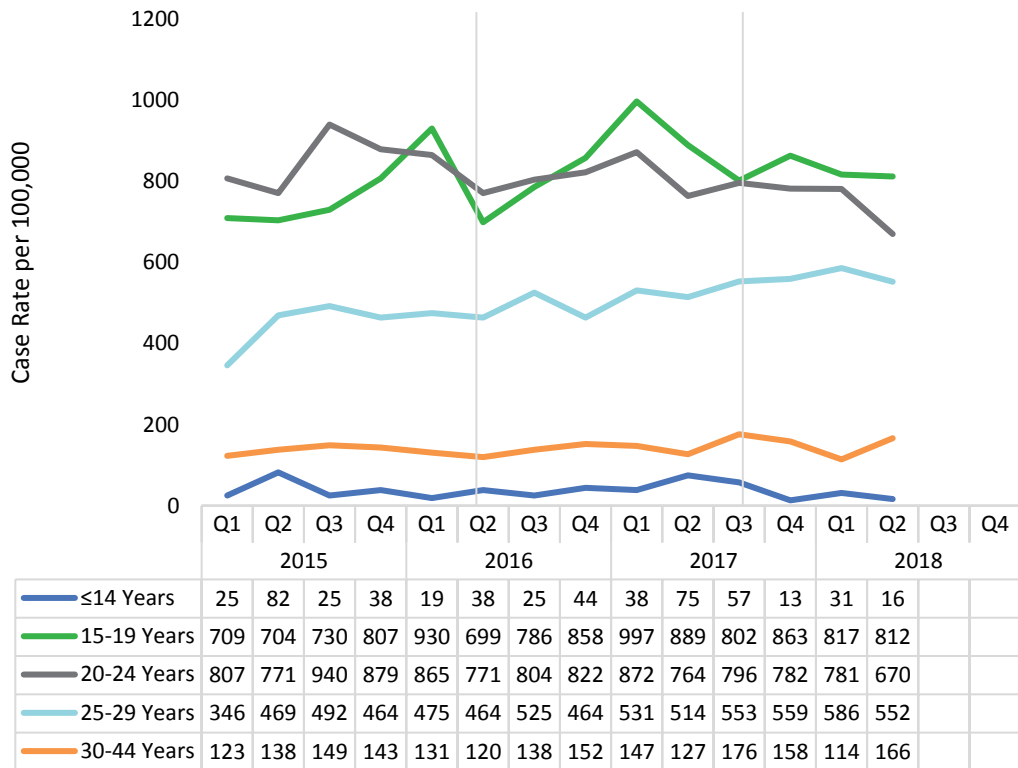
Chlamydia Rate by Sex



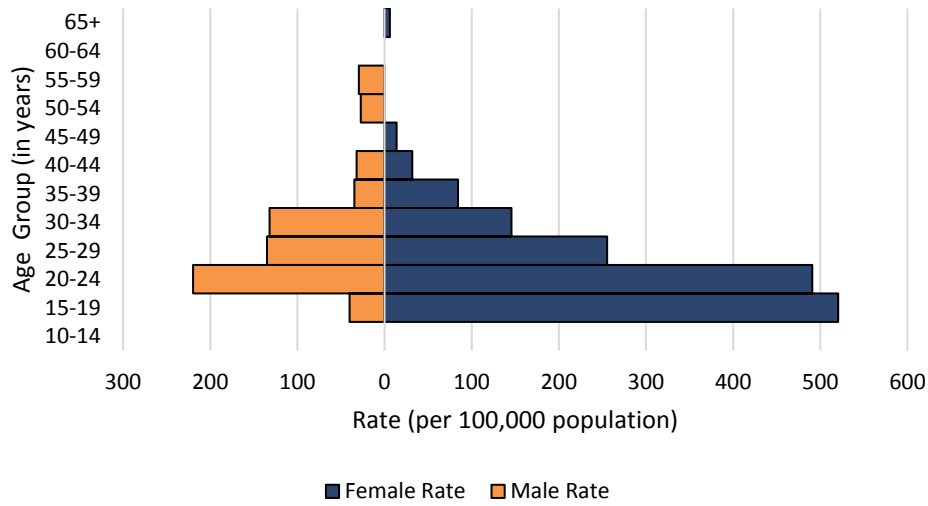
Chlamydia Rate by Race



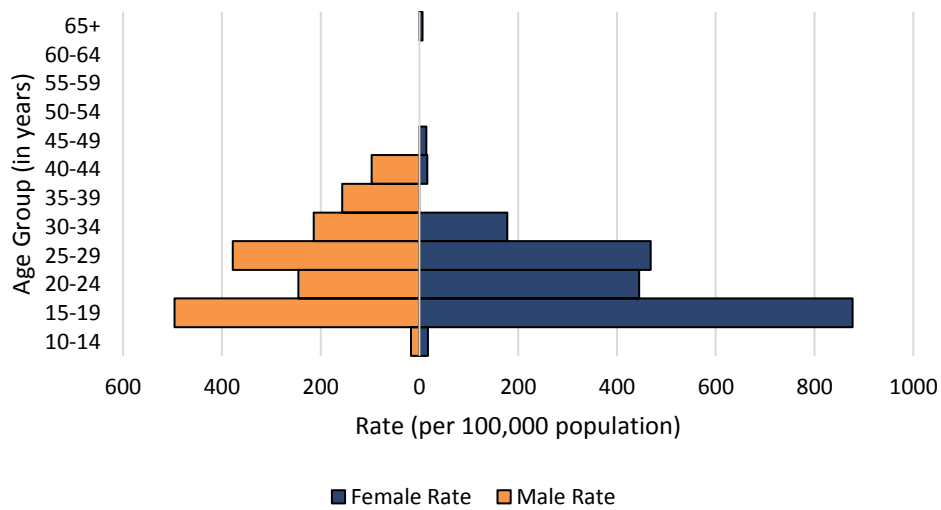
Chlamydia Rate by Age



Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, Caucasians, Quarter 2, 2018

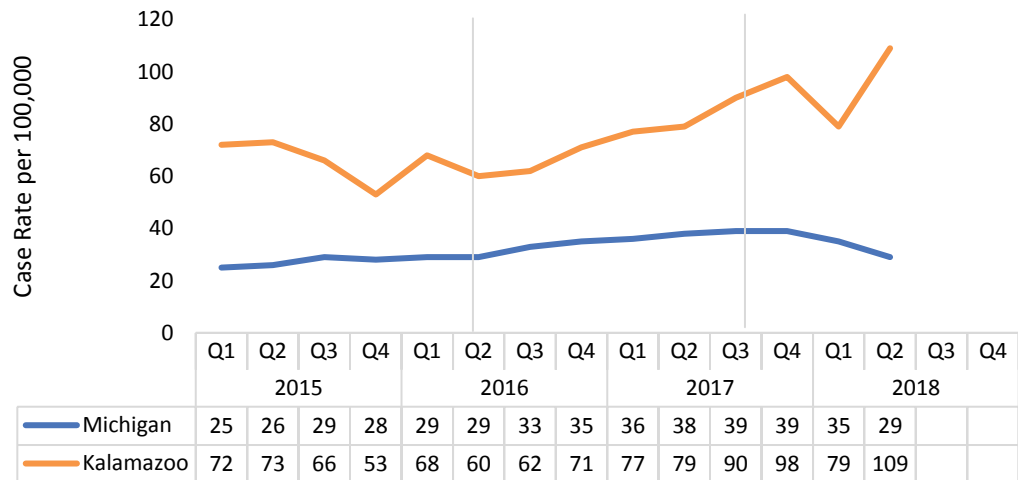


Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, African Americans, Quarter 2, 2018

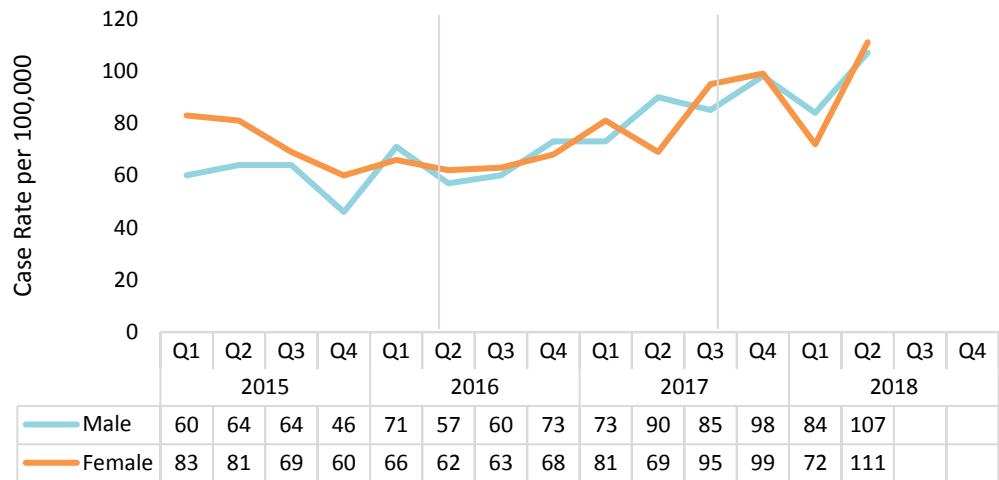

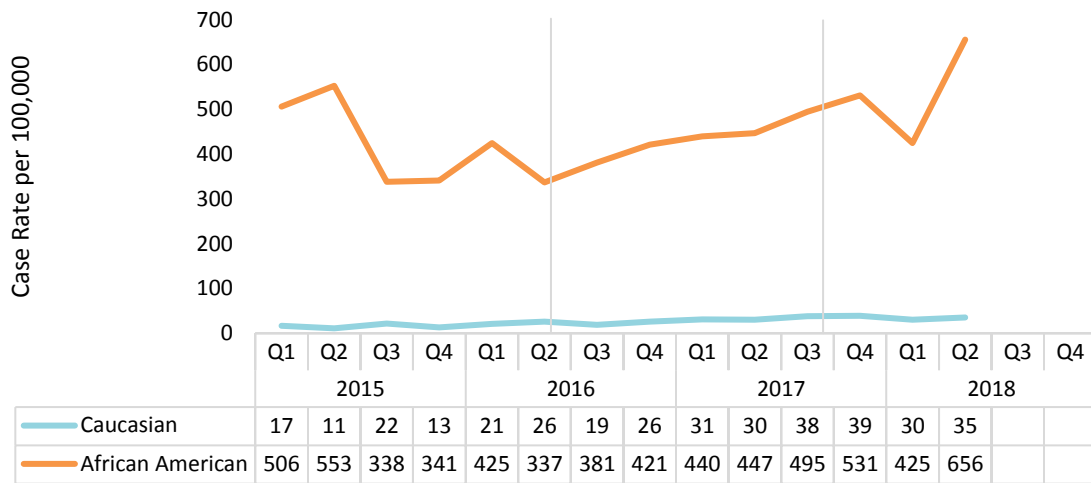
Gonorrhea Rate Michigan and Kalamazoo County



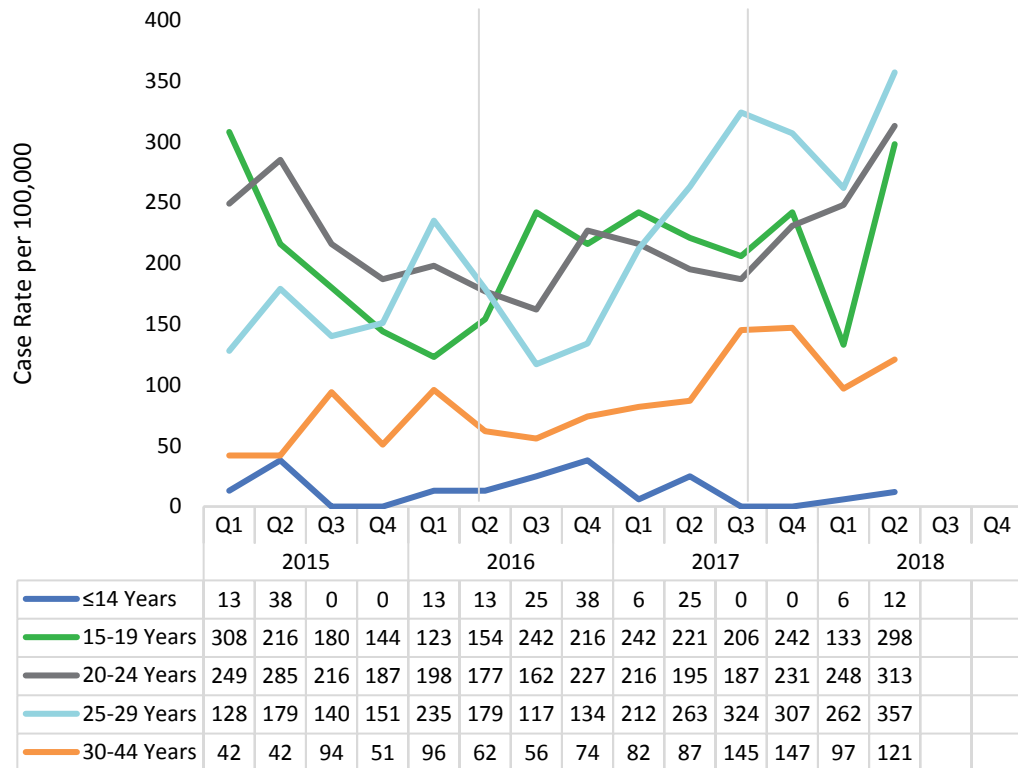
Gonorrhea Rates by Sex



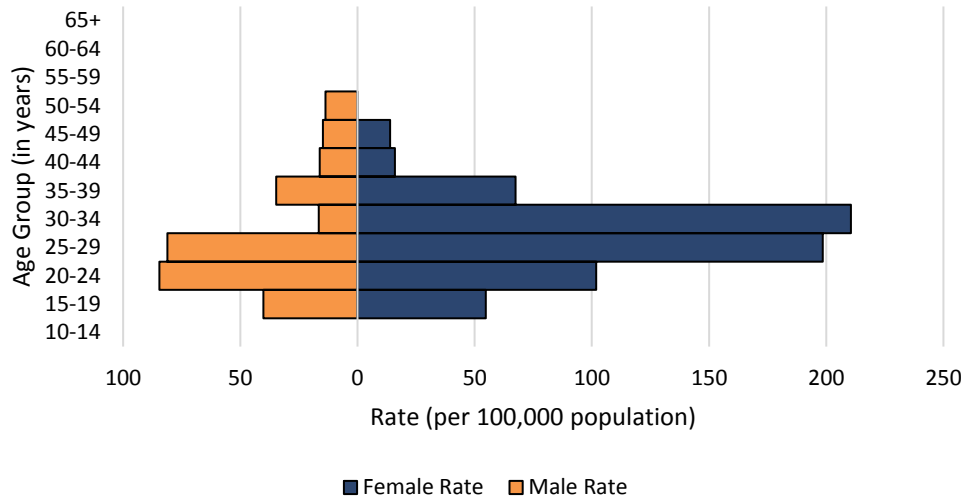
Gonorrhea Rates by Race



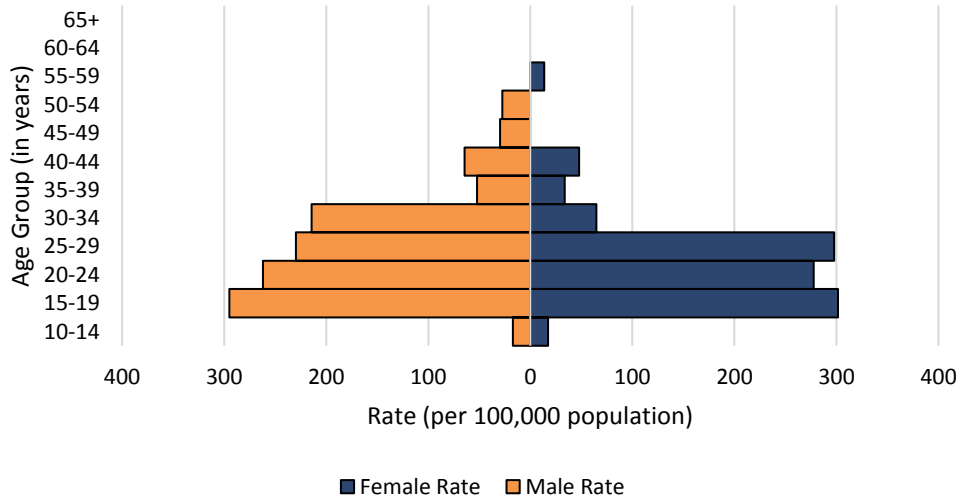
Gonorrhea Rates by Age
