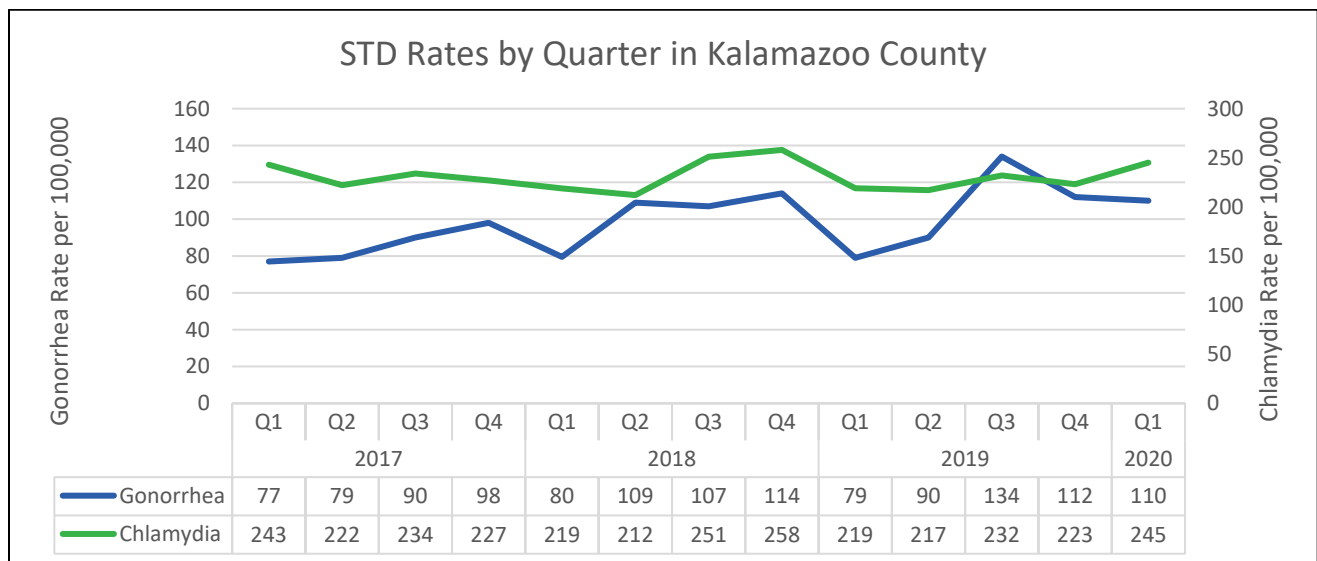
Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Quarterly Report

First Quarter 2020

Quick Facts:

- Chlamydia rates increased 12% compared to 1st quarter 2019 and increased 10% from 4th quarter 2019
- Chlamydia rates are higher in females, African Americans, and persons 15-24 years of age
- Gonorrhea rates increased 39% compared to 1st quarter 2019 and decreased 2% from 4th quarter 2019
- Gonorrhea rates are higher in African Americans and persons 30-44 years of age

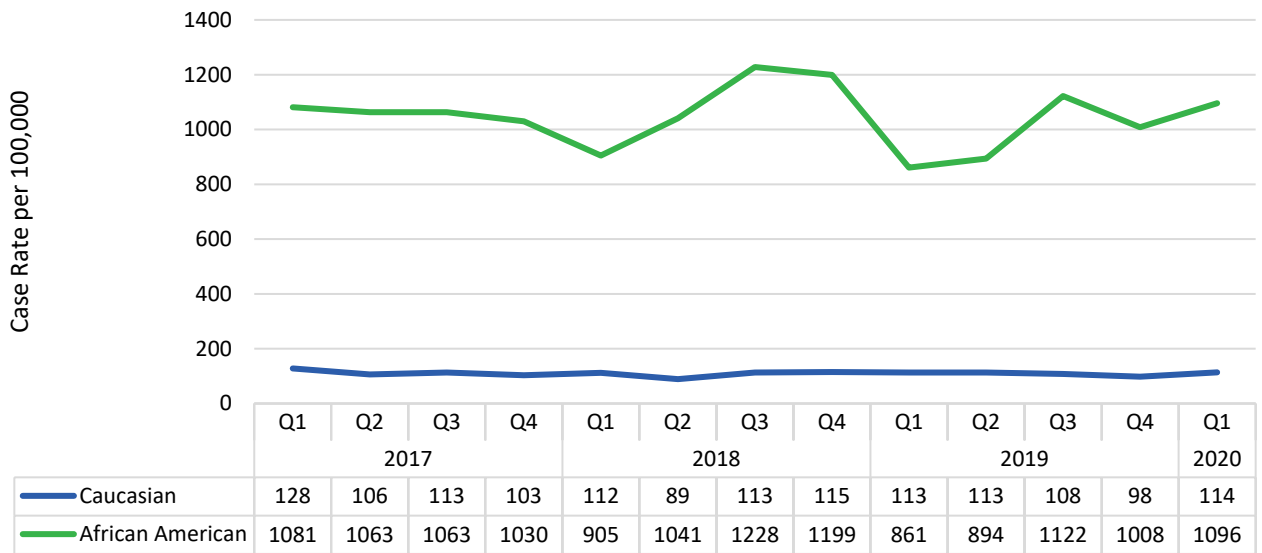

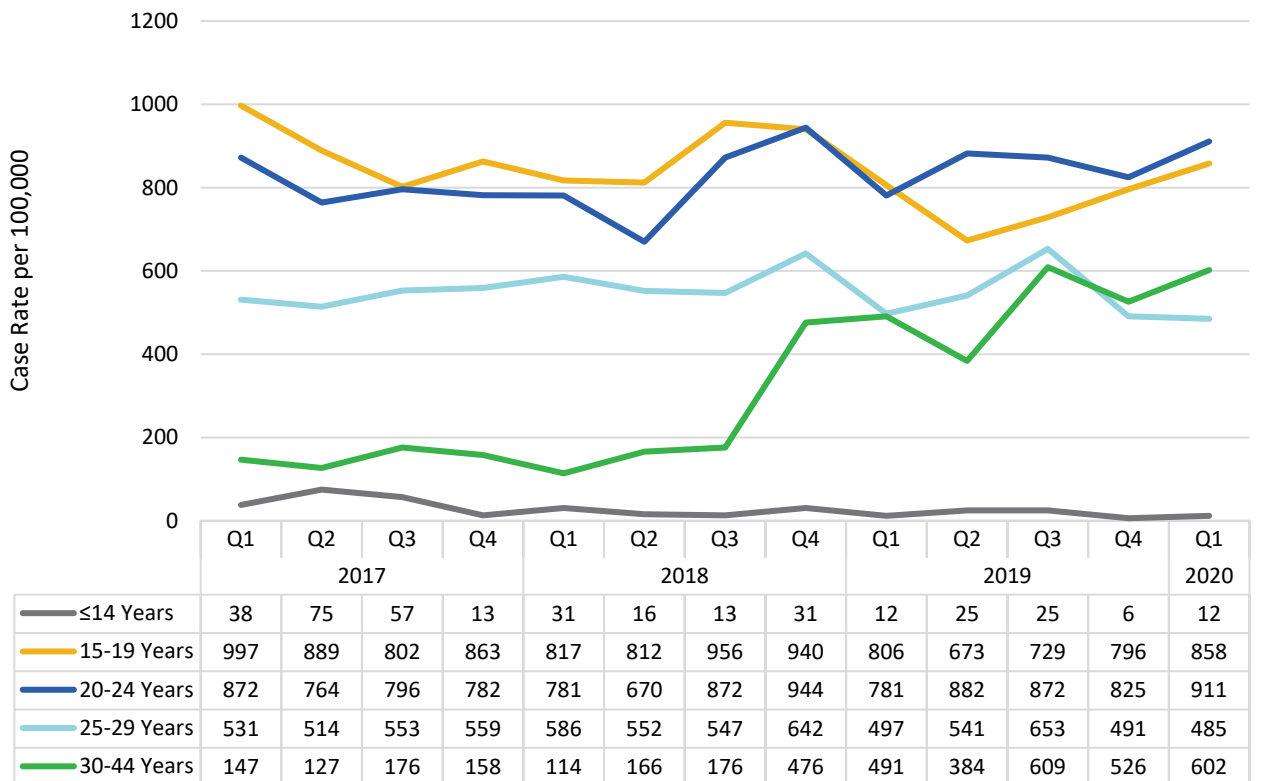

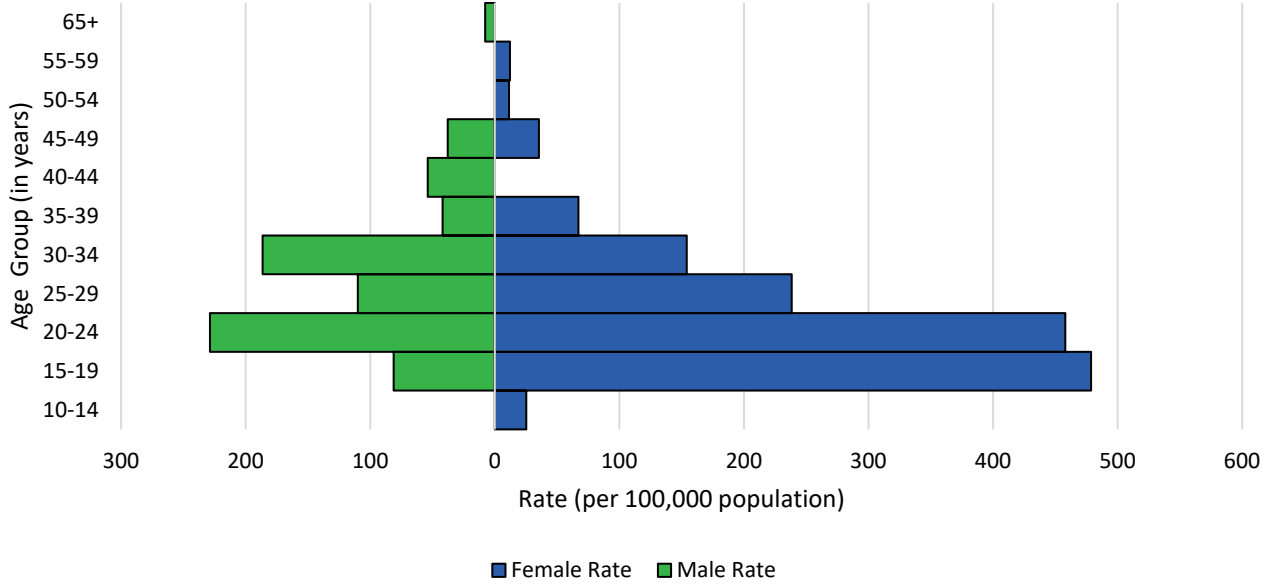
Chlamydia Rate by Race, Kalamazoo County



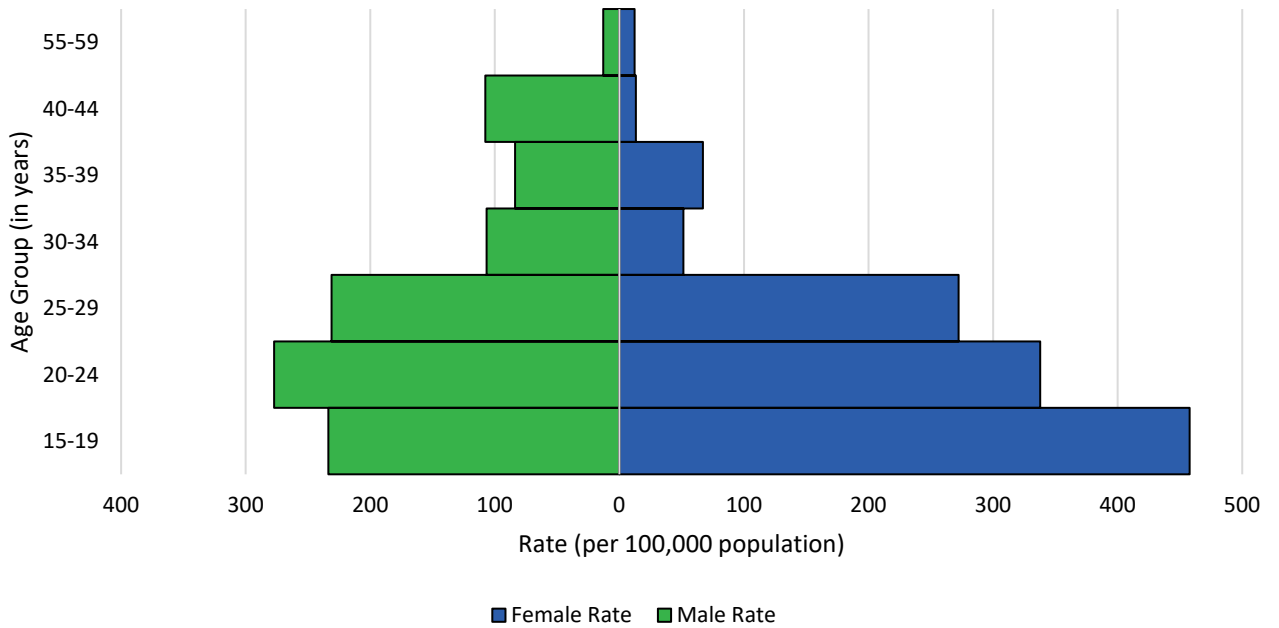
Chlamydia Rate by Age, Kalamazoo County



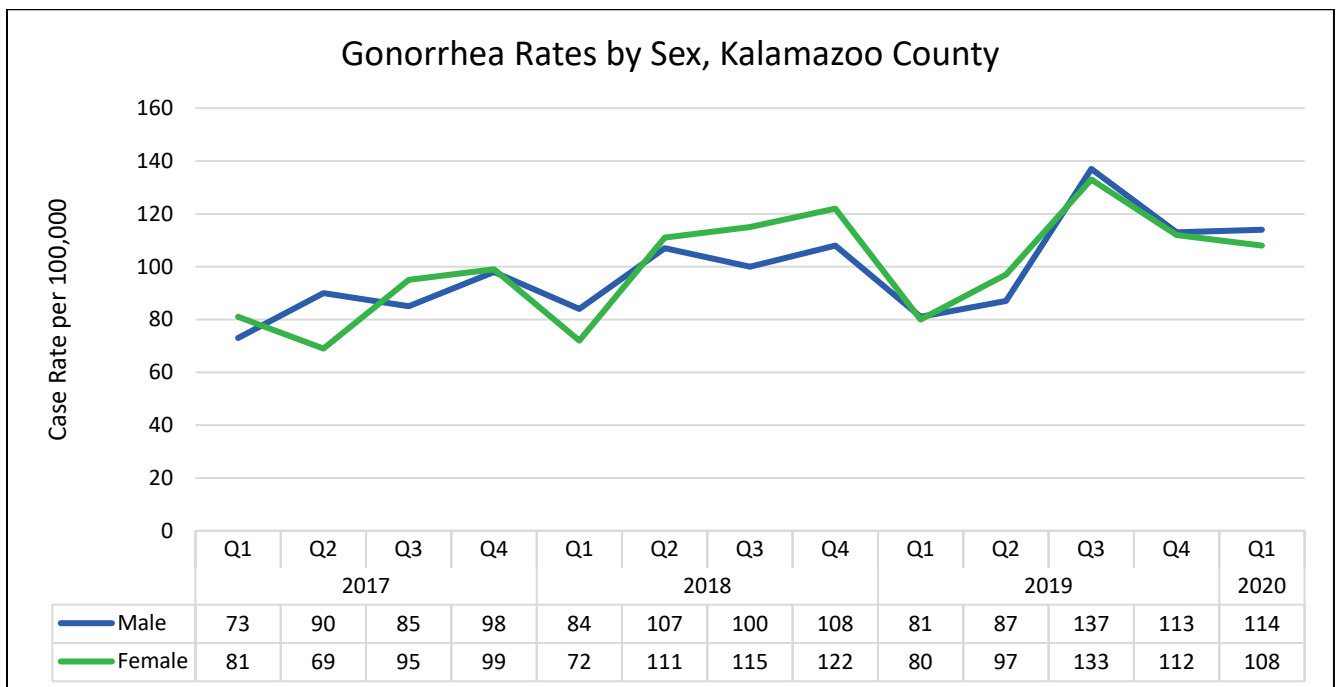
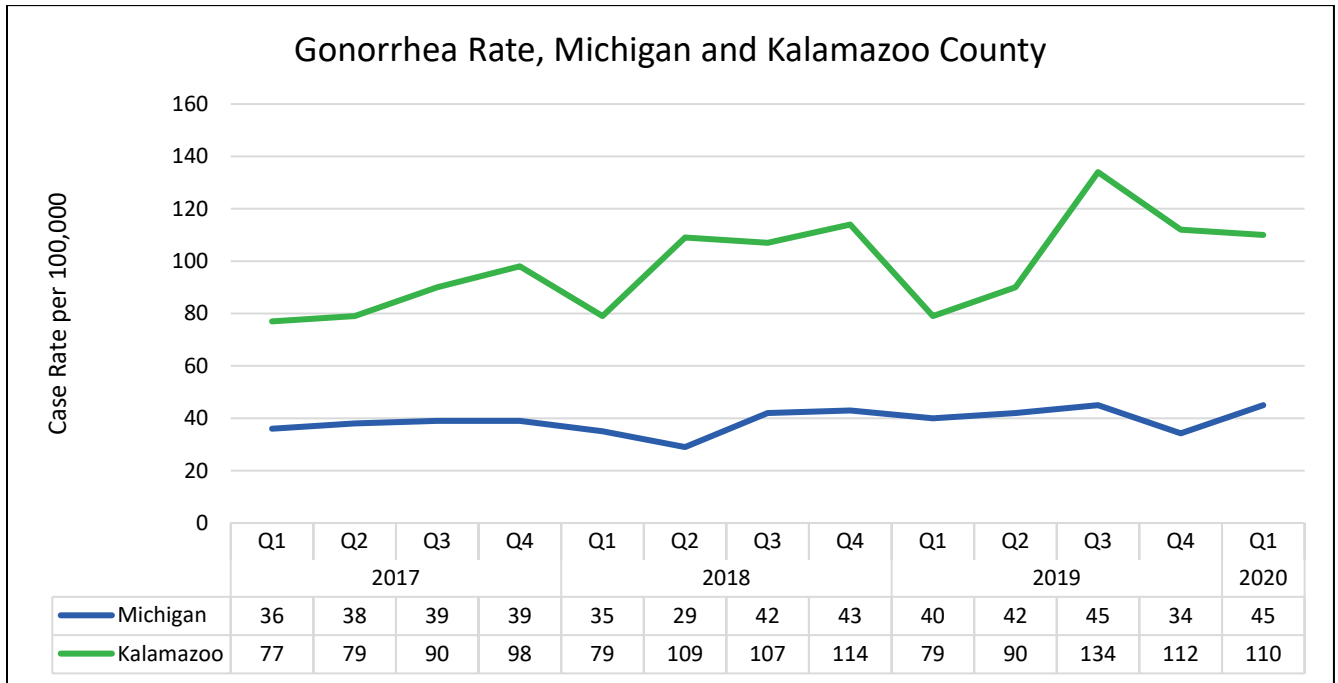
Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, Caucasians, Quarter 1, 2020



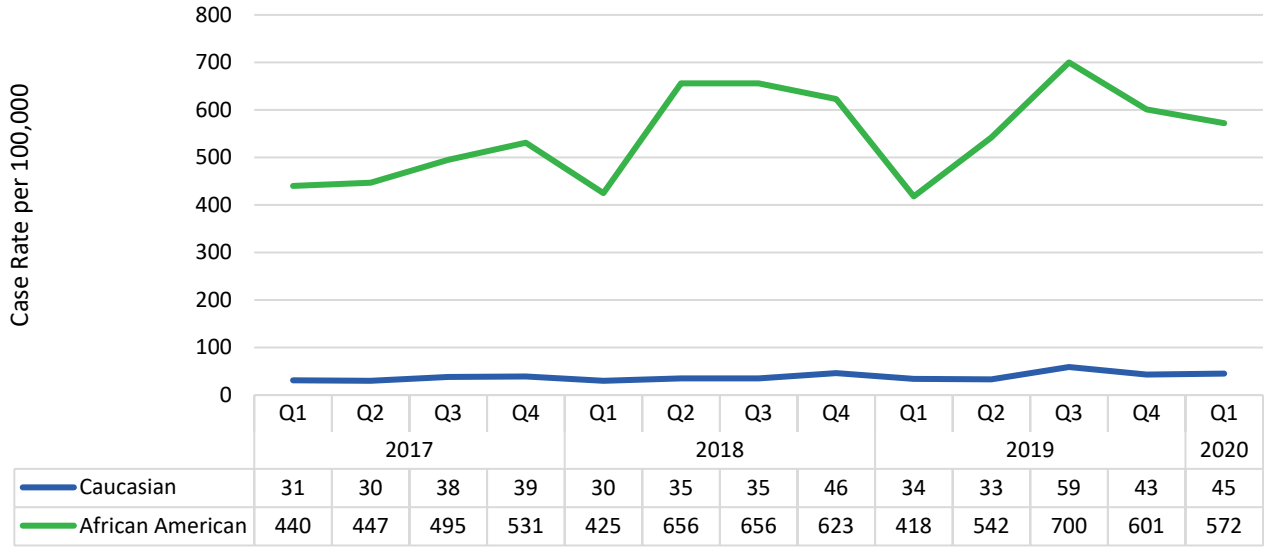
Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, African Americans, Quarter 1, 2020



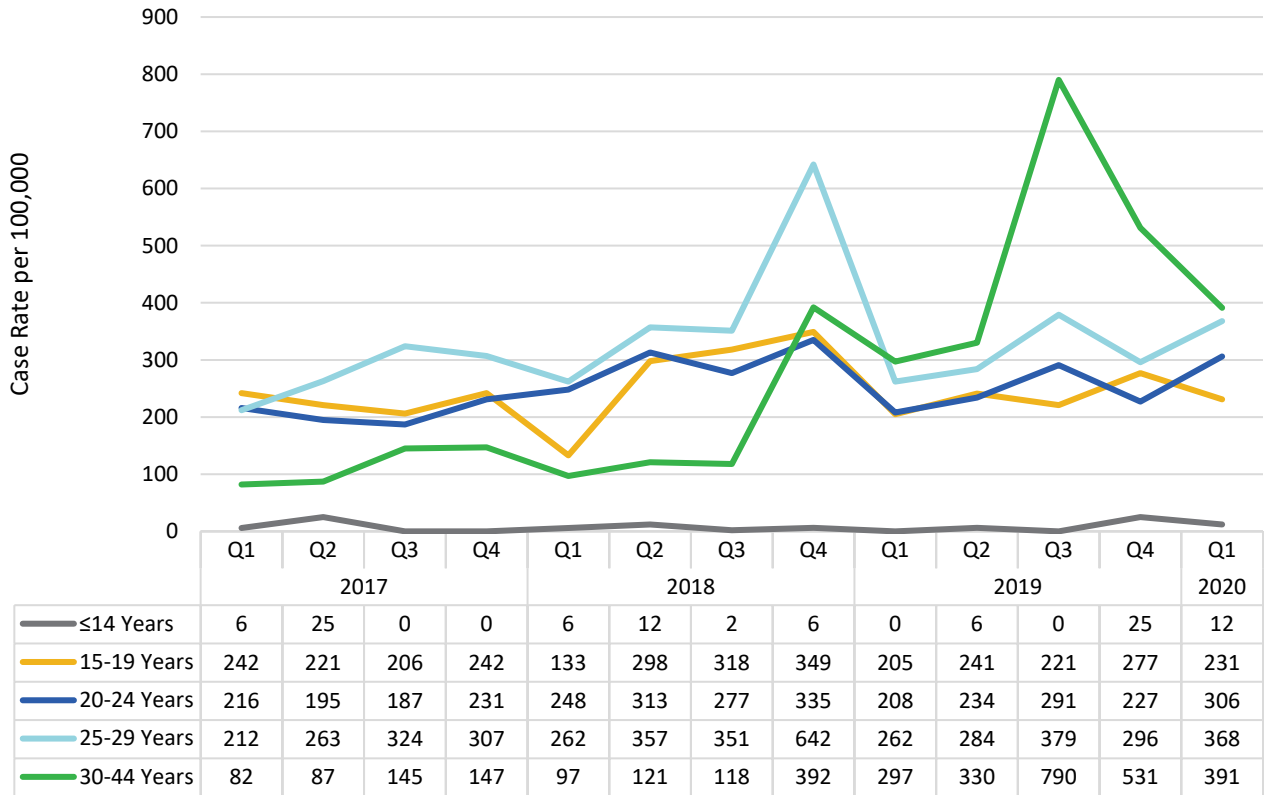

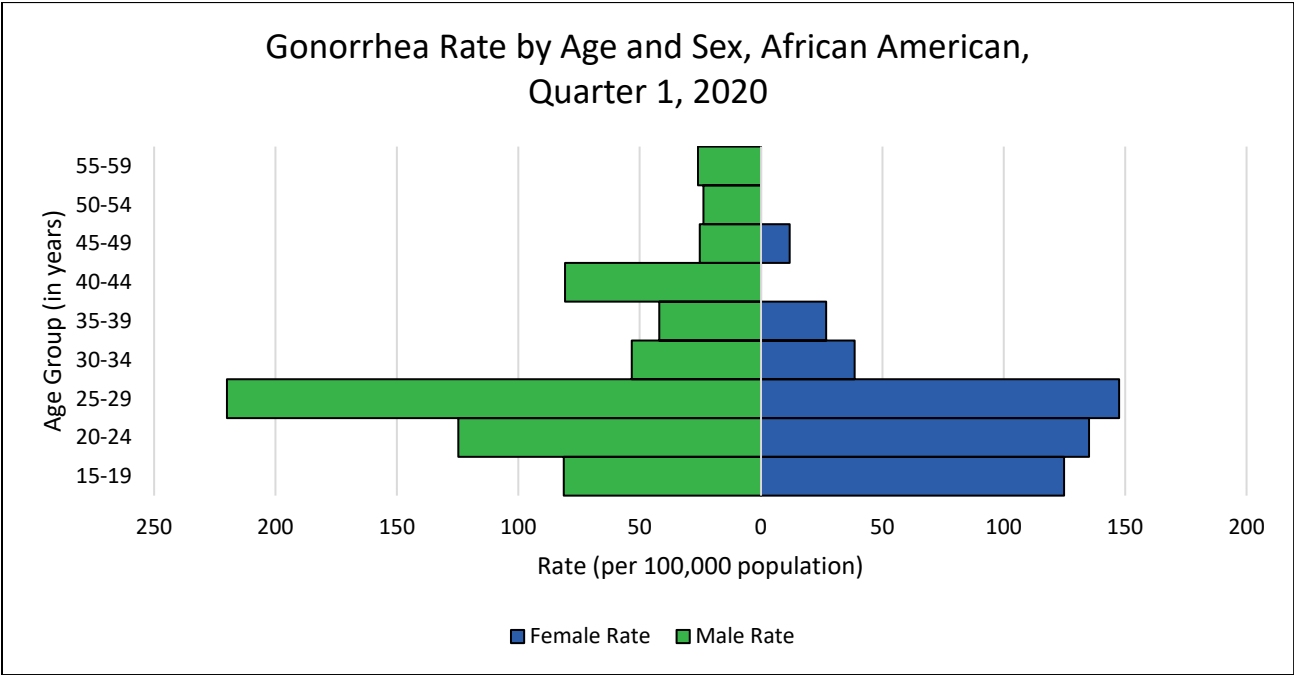
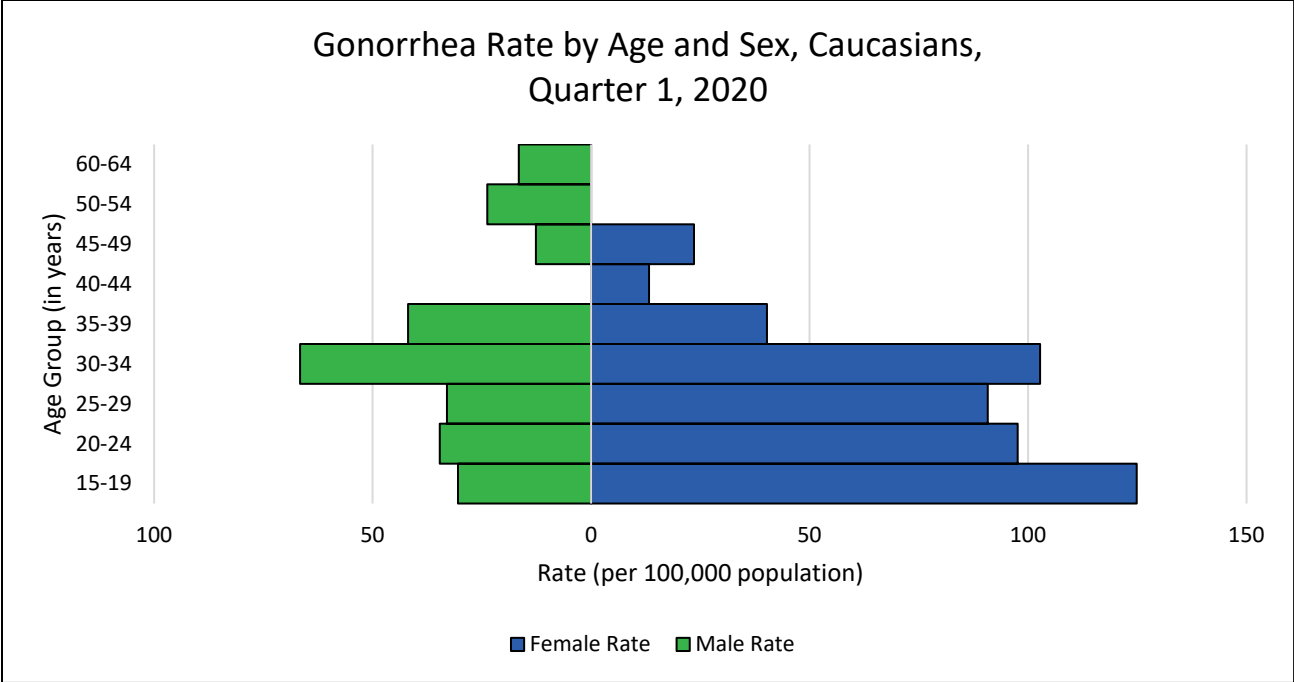


Gonorrhea Rates by Race, Kalamazoo County
