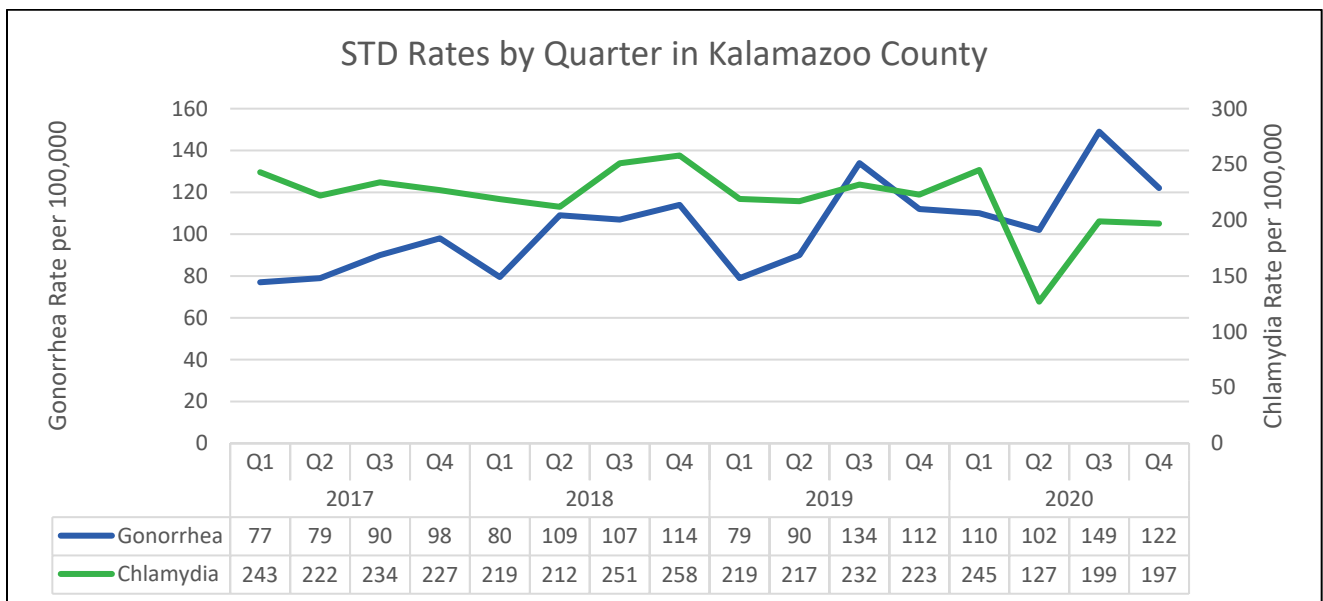
Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Quarterly Report

Fourth Quarter 2020

Quick Facts:

- Chlamydia rates increased 47% compared to 4th quarter 2019 and decreased 1% from 3rd quarter 2020
- Chlamydia rates are higher in females, African Americans, and persons 15-24 years of age
- Gonorrhea rates decreased 9% compared to 4th quarter 2019 and decreased 18% from 3rd quarter 2020
- Gonorrhea rates are higher in African Americans and persons 30-44 years of age

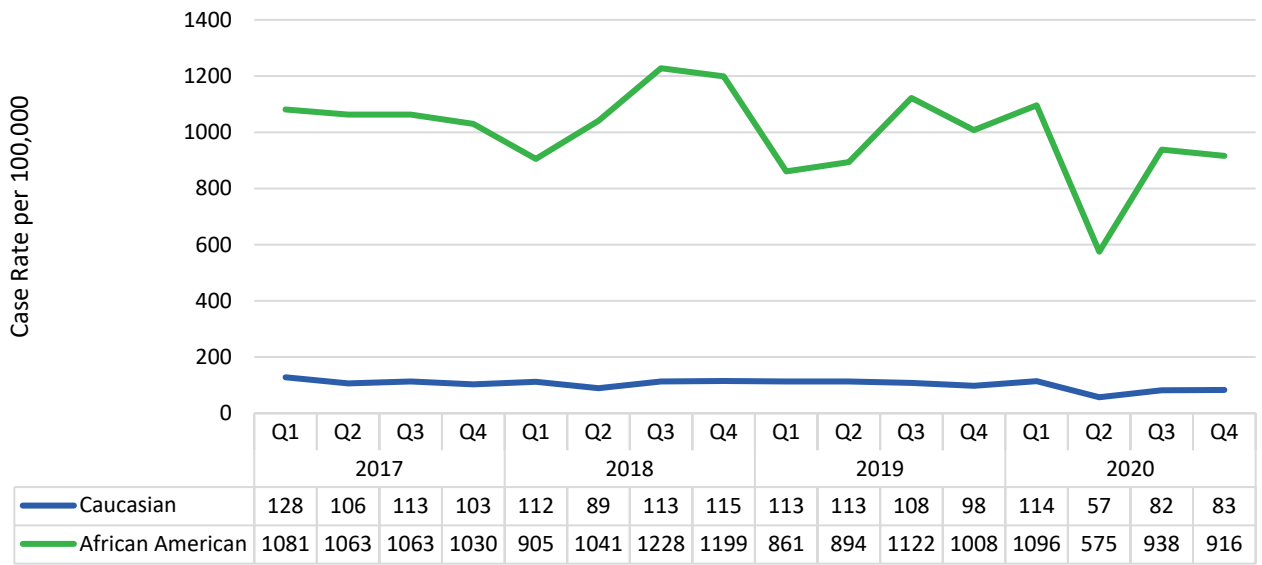

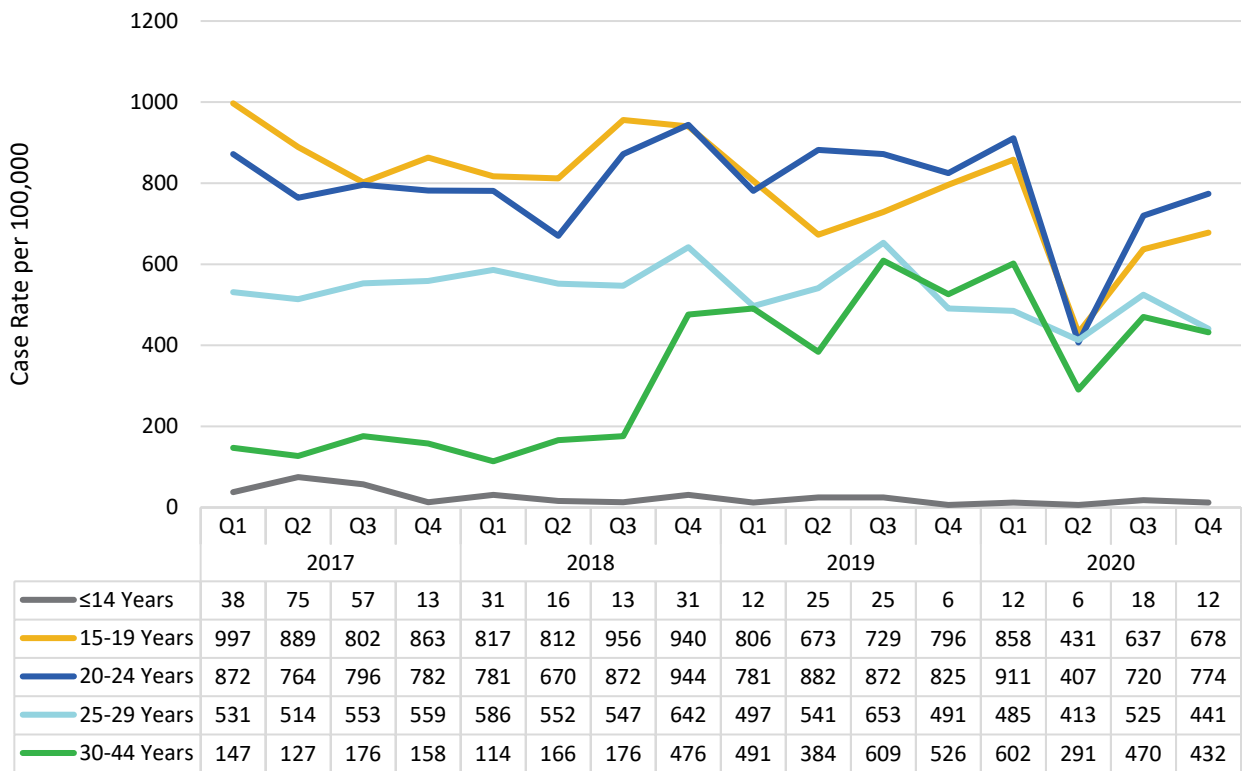

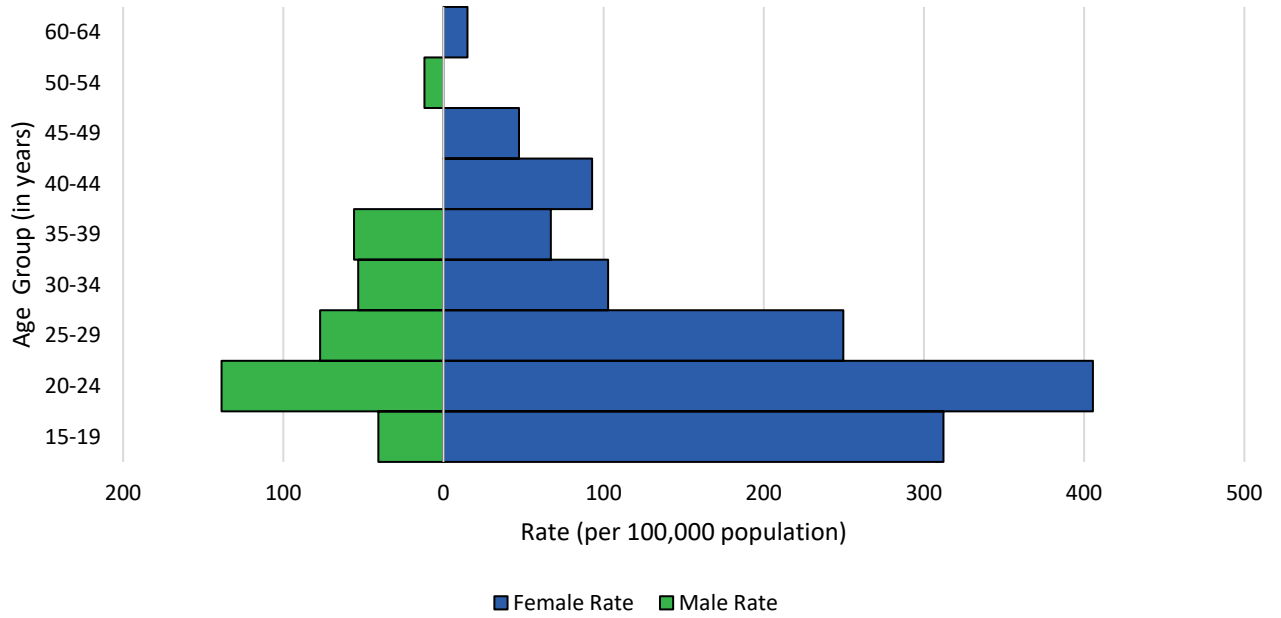
Chlamydia Rate by Race, Kalamazoo County



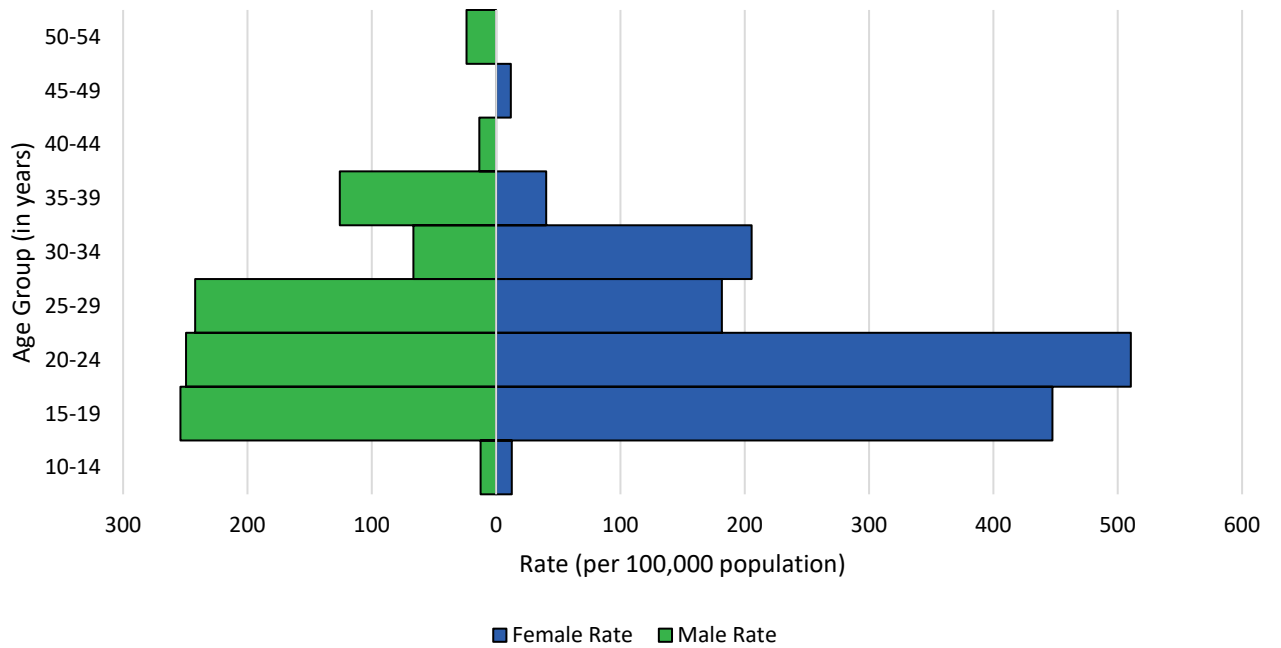
Chlamydia Rate by Age, Kalamazoo County



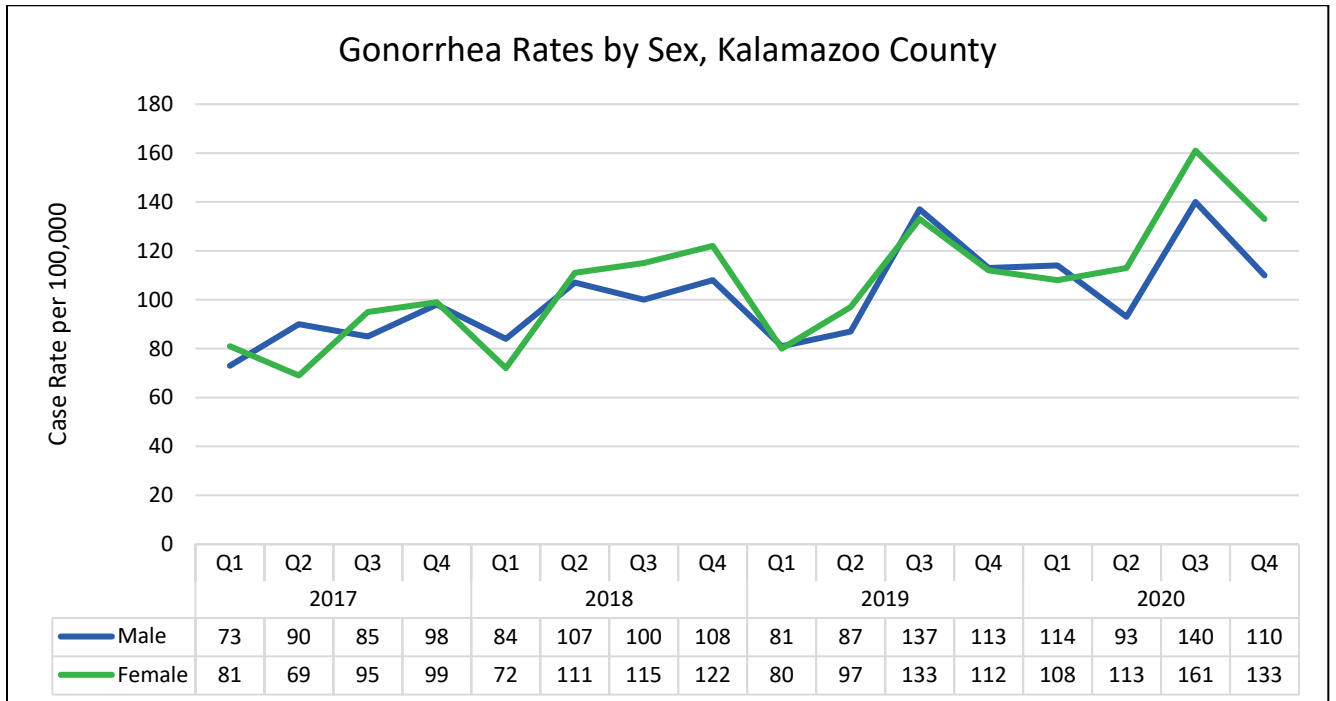
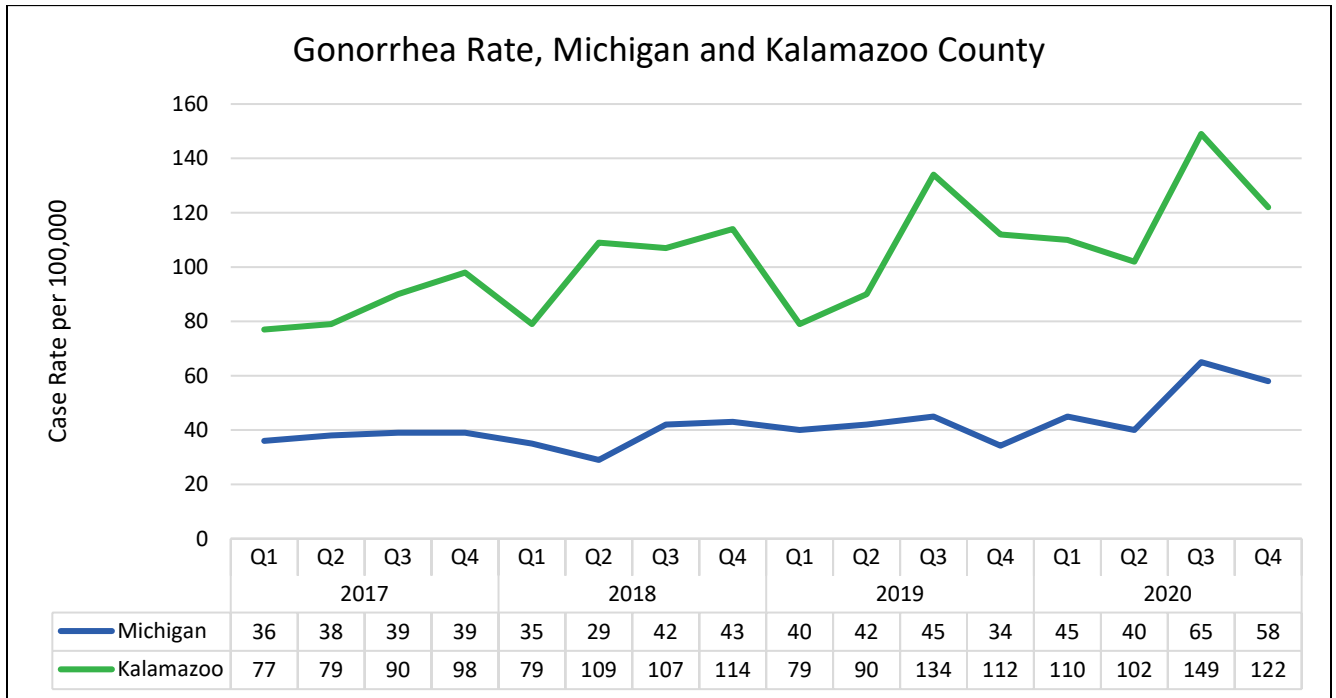
Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, Caucasians, Quarter 4, 2020



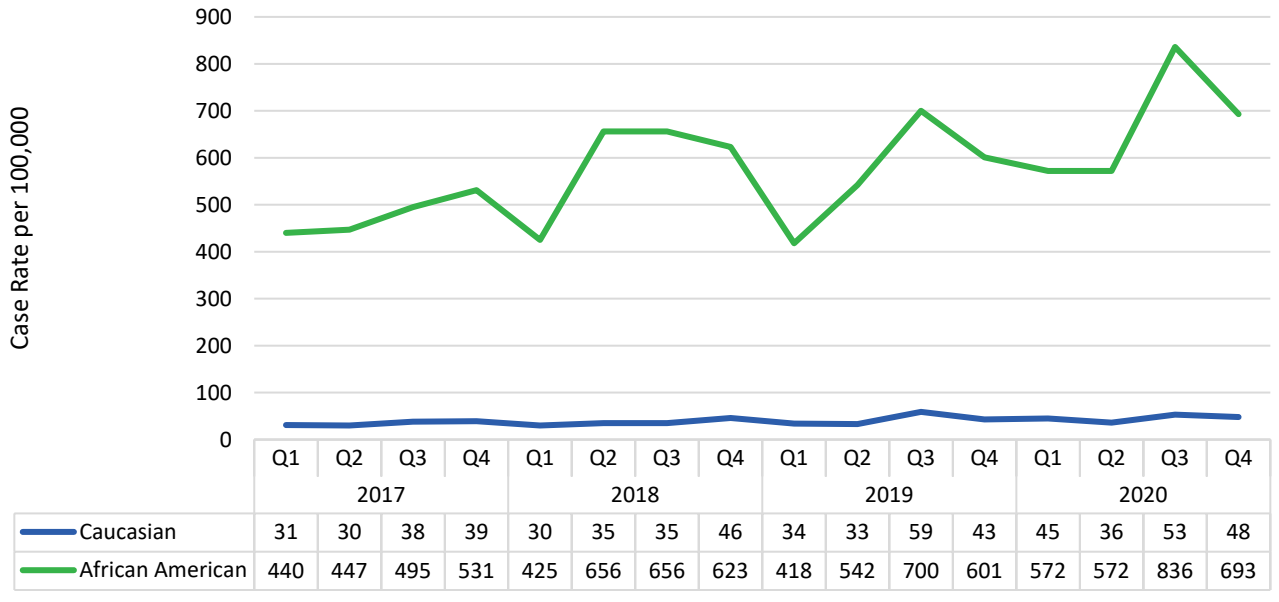
Chlamydia Rate by Age and Sex, African Americans, Quarter 4, 2020



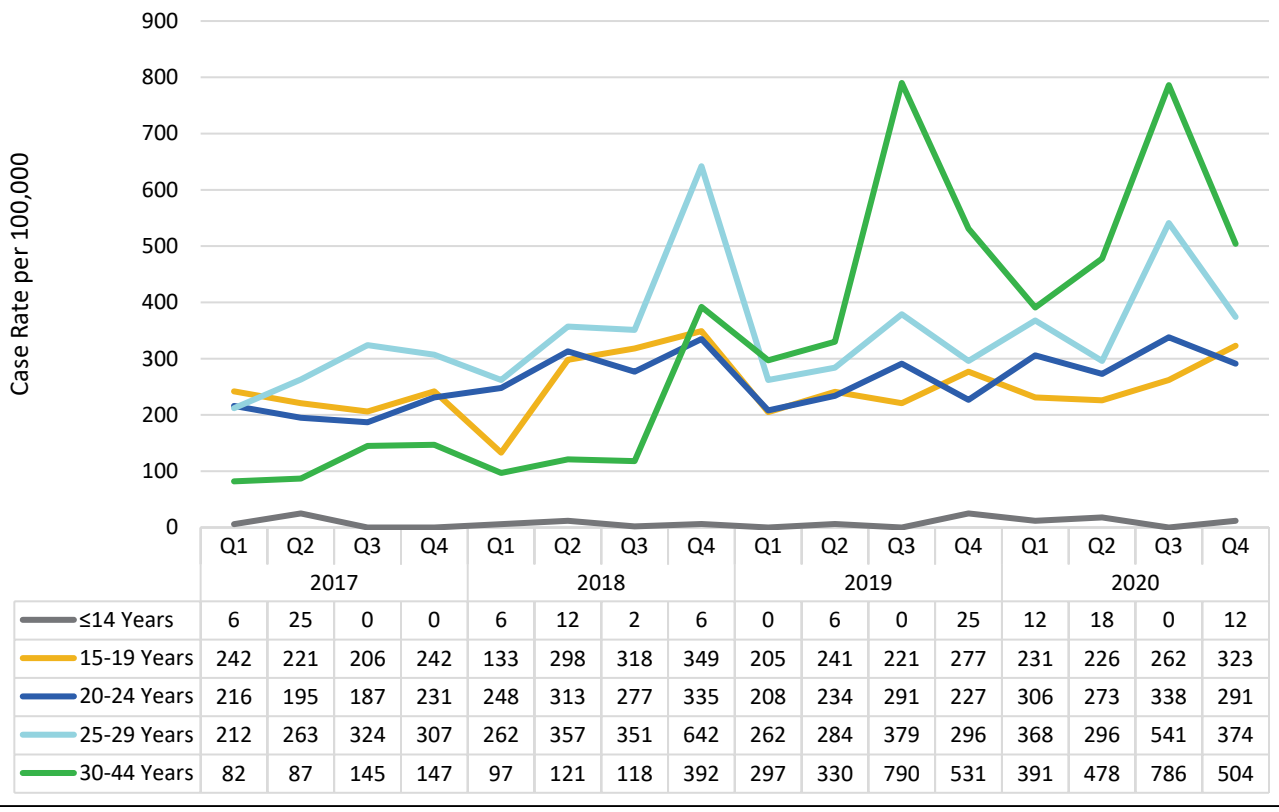

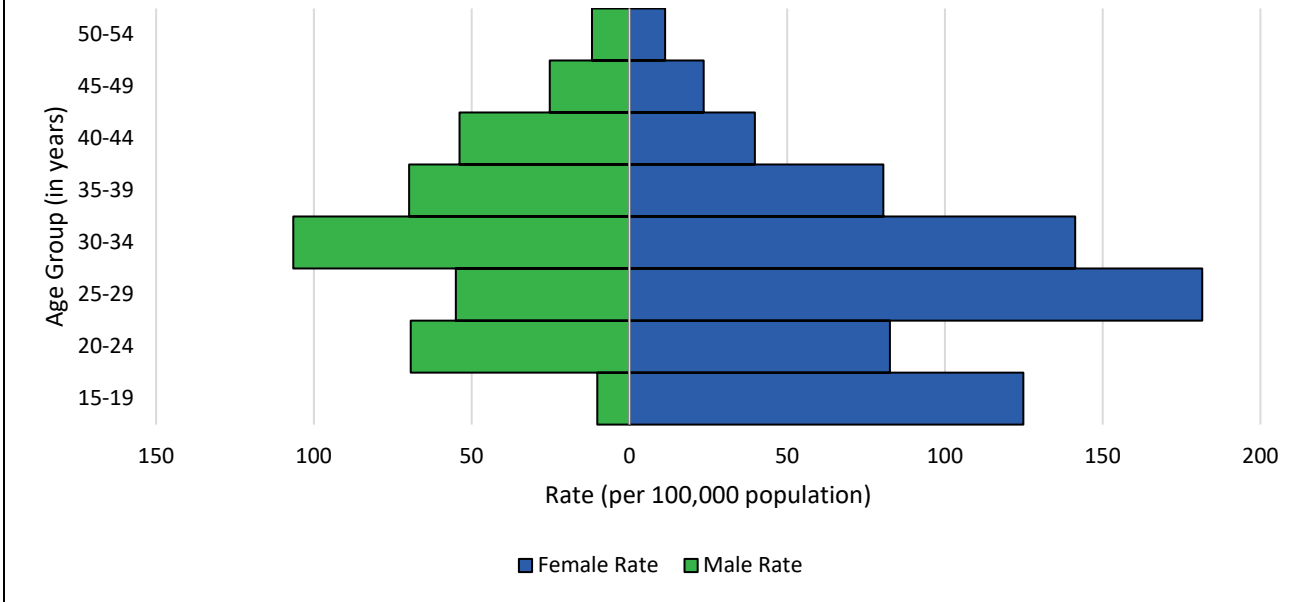
Gonorrhea Rates by Race, Kalamazoo County



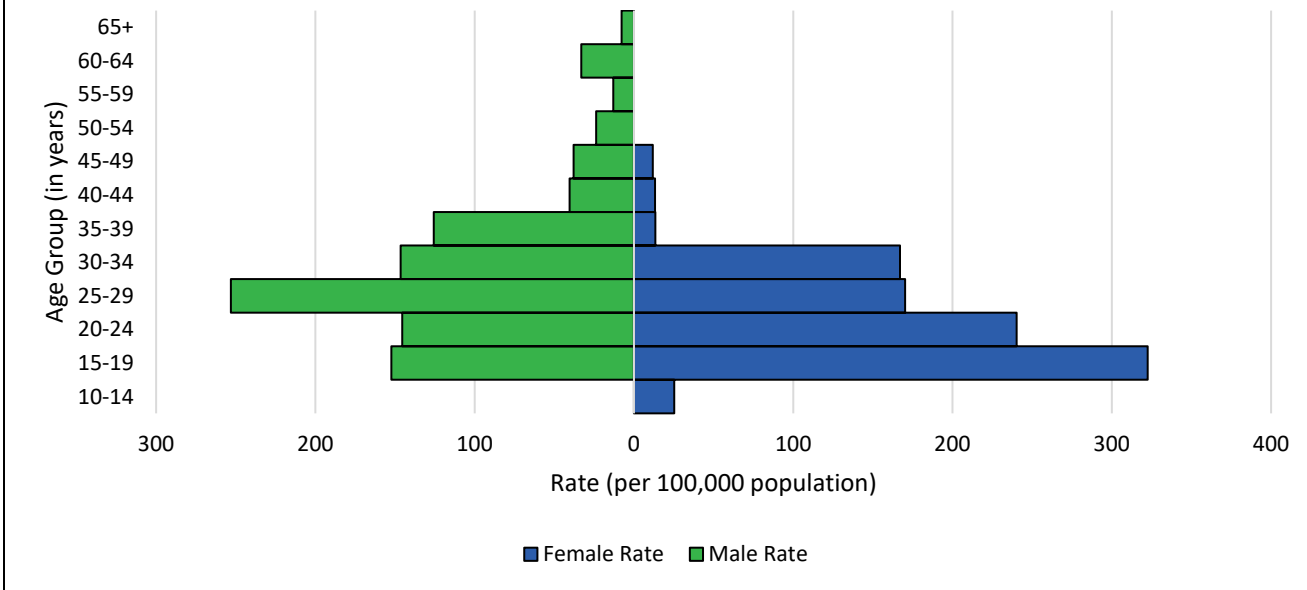
Gonorrhea Rates by Age, Kalamazoo County
