SUBJECT: Laboratory Certification Extension

In accordance with Gov. Gretchen Whitmer and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services' recommendations designed to help prevent the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), we have postponed the original inspection date of your laboratory. The state is taking proactive steps to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in Michigan. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in reducing the risk coronavirus to Michigan residents. The expiration date for the certification issued to the Kalamazoo County HCS Laboratory on February 27, 2020 has been extended to allow for the completion of the re-certification process. Our certification for the examination of drinking water is contingent on your continued compliance with state and federal regulations. Additionally, your certification is contingent on the submission of acceptable proficiency test sample results from a state-approved supplier on a running 12-month basis.

This administrative extension to your current certification expires on May 15, 2021. The certification period will be extended to cover the next 3-year certification period when your laboratory has successfully completed the re-certification process.
