## Campsite Reservations

1. Campsites can be reserved starting on the first business day in January of the current year.
2. Reservations are required. To make reservations, contact Kalamazoo County Parks at (269) 383-8778.
3. Reservations require a non-refundable \$5.00 reservation fee per site/reservation, and full payment of camping fees.
4. All campsites must be reserved in advance and you can reserve specific sites or groups of sites together.
5. Reservation changes and cancellations must be made by the reservation holder.
6. Selling, renting or transferring a campsite is prohibited. Reservations must be canceled if they cannot be used by the original reservation holder. Staff may not honor a reservation that has been transferred.

## Kalamazoo County Parks Campground Rules

1. Do not set up campers/tents until a campsite is assigned and fees are paid.
2. **Occupancy limited to immediate family or up to four single persons. Not more than one camping unit per site. An additional tent is permitted for dependent juveniles.**
3. Camping permits may be issued for up to 14 consecutive nights. Additional nights can be registered after 48 hour absence from campground.
4. Reservations are held until 3pm the day after the scheduled arrival date. Cancellation policy will apply and no refunds will be issued after the scheduled arrival date. The party registered for the site shall remain at the site for the entire stay.
5. Anyone camping, under the age of 18, shall be accompanied by an adult.
6. **Check in time is 3:00 p.m. Check out time is 1:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 3:00 p.m. on Sundays.**
7. Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. Generators, radios shall not be used during quiet time.
8. **Visitors to Campground Sites are permitted between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.**
9. Fires are permitted only in fire pits and grills. Collecting firewood at Kalamazoo County Parks is prohibited. Firewood is for sale at the gatehouse.
10. Fireworks are not permitted.
11. All gray water must be disposed of at the designated park dump station. Water outlets at campsites are available to obtain water for campsites. Washing of vehicles, dishes, clothes, pets or person at these outlets or in the sinks in service buildings is prohibited.
12. Sanitation/dump station use is limited to registered campers. Registering for a site solely to utilize sanitation/dump station is prohibited.
13. **Two vehicles parked per site. Additional vehicles and guest vehicles must be parked in the visitor parking lot.**
14. Dogs must be on a leash no more than 6 feet long, at all times. No dog will be allowed to be left unattended. Dogs are not permitted in swimming beach area. Owners must clean up after pets.
15. No person shall engage in any violent, abusive, boisterous, loud, illegal, obscene or similar disorderly conduct which unreasonably interferes with another person's use or enjoyment of a facility. Radios, generators or other amplified devices may not be used in a manner that creates excessive noise.
16. Barrier-Free campsites will be reserved only to persons with mobility impairments. Individuals must have State of Michigan Handicap Parking Permit or must provide staff written medical documentation. Designated sites will be held as the last available sites rented to any camper.
17. No person shall tie animals, clotheslines, tents, hammocks or items to trees. One picnic table per site.
18. **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY – DIAL 911**

**Cancellation Policy:** Reservation fees are non-refundable. If you cancel your reservation two weeks prior to the first night's stay, your refund will be the camping fees paid less a \$5.00 cancellation fee. If your reservation is cancelled or changed less than two weeks from your first night's stay, your refund will be the camping fees paid less the amounts paid for the first two nights camping and a \$5.00 cancellation fee. No camping fee refunds will be given for cancellations or changes on the day of or after the first day of reservation.

Choosing to violate any of Kalamazoo County Parks or Campground rules may result in eviction and/or prosecution.
