PROCLAIMING MAY 15 AS PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL DAY AND PROCLAIMING MAY 12 – 18 AS NATIONAL POLICE WEEK IN KALAMAZOO COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Congress and President of the United States have designated May 15 as Peace Officers Memorial Day, and the week in which May 15 falls as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, the members of the law enforcement agencies of Kalamazoo County play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of Kalamazoo County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Kalamazoo County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim May 15, 2024, as Peace Officers Memorial Day, and May 12-18, 2024, as National Police Week in Kalamazoo County, and publicly salute the service of law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.
