Upon review of the court case listed above, the following order ensures that the sentencing hearing in this matter is conducted in an orderly manner.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Schedule and seating

- a) Sentencing is scheduled for Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom D, located on the 2nd floor of the Michigan Avenue Courthouse. The courthouse will open at 7:45 a.m.
- b) Specified seating in Courtroom D will be provided on a limited basis for victims and victims' families, defendant's family, representatives of the media and public. There are approximately 35 seats available for victims and victims' families, 6 seats for the defendant's family, 13 seats available for media representatives and 11 seats for members of the public.

2. Media

- a) The Court has selected and authorized WOOD TV Channel 8 as the media organization to provide the video pool feed from the courtroom. No additional recording cameras are permitted in the courtroom. The Court has selected MLive as the media organization to provide still photographs from the courtroom. The Court has selected WMUK-FM as the media organization providing radio coverage. The media shall be solely responsible for arranging an open and impartial distribution scheme of all pool coverage. Neither judges nor other court personnel shall be called upon to resolve any disputes concerning such pooling arrangements.
- b) WOOD TV will be providing audio/video coverage utilizing a remote-operated video camera. Media organizations previously credentialed for the trial will have access to the pool feed in the media room and/or access to the courtroom. Broadcasting from the pool feed with no less than a two-minute delay is permitted on a live monitored feed only.
- c) Any dispute among media will be decided by the media organizations collectively.

3. Security

- a) The Kalamazoo County Sheriff Department shall be responsible for court security, including maintaining order and decorum in the courthouse. All orders given by Kalamazoo County Sheriff Department shall be deemed orders of this Court and must be complied with. Failure to do so may subject such persons to sanctions by the Court, including, but not limited to, exclusion from the courtroom or courthouse.
- b) All individuals and belongings entering the courthouse must pass through security screening. For additional information regarding prohibited items see: <http://www.kalcounty.com/courts/security.htm>. All individuals and belongings are subject to security screening inside the courthouse.
- c) To assist with security and public access, no interviews shall be held inside the courthouse. The Court has designated the courthouse steps facing Bronson Park as the media location for press conferences, interviews, still pictures and film coverage. In the event of inclement weather, the Court will notify all media representatives of the alternate interview location

4. Courtroom Decorum

- a) Except for authorized media, no person shall take any photograph, make any recording or make any broadcasting by any means, at any time from within the courthouse.
- b) Except for credentialed media representatives, the use of electronic devices including, but not limited to cellular phones, laptops, tablets, recorders, Bluetooth-enabled watches, GoPro Cameras, by anyone is prohibited in the courtroom. Improper use will result in the confiscation of the device.
- c) Attendees in the courtroom may not converse or make gestures or sounds that are disruptive to the proceedings.
- d) Attendees in the courtroom must remain seated until the Court recesses.
- e) Anyone in the courthouse is prohibited from wearing or carrying any clothing, buttons, or other items that display any message or symbol addressing the issues related to this case.
- f) No food or beverage is allowed in the courthouse.
