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BCCCNP ELIGIBILITY

Please use the following criteria to determine client eligibility:

Age:

- Women age 40 to 64 for breast screening/diagnostic/treatment services, priority age 50+
- Women age 21-64 for cervical screening/diagnostic/treatment services
- Women age 25-39, breast diagnostic services only

Residency & Citizenship

- Current Michigan Resident
- Migrant Worker
- Women living near the MI border who plan to receive screening/diagnostic services in Michigan

Insurance

- No Insurance coverage or Underinsured with High Deductible
- Women with Medicare A & B are not eligible to apply

Income

Family income maximum 250% of poverty level:

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Yearly Income (250% FPL)</u>
1	\$31,225
2	\$42,275
3	\$53,325
4	\$64,375

Each additional member add \$11,050
