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BC3NP Guidelines for eligible patients

IMPORTANT:

PHYSICAL BILLING YEAR ENDS 6/30/2021

Billing for PY21 Claims – DOS 07/01/2020 – 06/30/2021

- ORIGINAL (1st time) claim submission – **07/15/2021**, including claims awaiting primary insurance Explanation of Benefits (EOBs)
- Any *original* PY21 claims received after 07/15/2021 will be rejected with the hold code "N5" (prior fiscal year) and/or adjustment code "29" (timely filing)
- Resubmission of CORRECTED claims: **THERE IS NO RESUBMISSION/CORRECTION TIME PERIOD.**

Please remember that BC3NP is not insurance.

- As a grant-funded program, BC3NP is limited to paying for services related to breast and cervical cancer screening services only.
- Clinic and billing staff need to work together to ensure services get paid.

REMINDER:

DO NOT USE Z00.00 (ICD-10 code) WHEN BILLING FOR BC3NP SERVICES. THIS IS A GENERAL WELLNESS CODE AND NOT SPECIFIC TO BREAST/CERVICAL SERVICES.



CREDENTIALING PROCESS BEGINS

HELP US IDENTIFY BC3NP PATIENTS

BC3NP is a screening program. Since Healthcare reform most of our former clients are eligible for Healthy Michigan Plan Medicaid. Additionally many are signing up for insurance through the Healthcare Marketplace. But, will their coverage include diagnostics after an abnormal screening? BC3NP caseload is still available to women who might be falling through the cracks. Please help us find these patients.

BC3NP has the flexibility to enroll patients anywhere along the continuum of care from breast or cervical screening to diagnosis. Where is the gap in coverage for your patient? Who at your agency will discover this gap and contact BC3NP for help?

Refer to the flyer included with this newsletter. Print it. Post it for your providers and staff. Forward this information to your network of providers. Keep the information handy.

Many patients do not understand their own coverage. Help them learn what they have and how to use it. If you discover a need for breast or cervical screening or diagnostics, let us know! Help us find our BC3NP patients.
