Who Qualifies for BCCCNP?

Age:

- Women age 40 to 64 for breast/cervical screening/diagnostic/treatment services
- Women age 21-39 for breast/cervical diagnostic services

Residency & Citizenship

- Current Michigan Resident
- Migrant Worker
- Women living near the border of a neighboring state who plan to receive screening and diagnostic services in Michigan

Insurance

- No Insurance coverage or High Deductible
- Women who are enrolled in a managed care program, a health maintenance organization, or Medicare Part B are NOT eligible for the BCCCNP

Income

- Family income maximum 250% of poverty level. (See Income Chart)

SW MI BCCCNP Clinics are available in 8 Counties: Allegan, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Kalamazoo, Van Buren and St. Joseph.

Medicaid through BCCCNP

BCCCNP-eligible women with a NEW breast or cervical cancer diagnosis may apply for straight Medicaid through BCCCNP. This will reduce patient costs during treatment.

NEW - Clients enrolled in Michigan's Healthy Michigan Plan (HMP) or another type of Medicaid: ARE eligible to transfer to BCCCNP MTA at any point during their cancer treatment.

Income Guidelines

Women may enroll in BCCCNP for screening and/or diagnostic services prior to or during the time they are also applying for Healthy Michigan Plan.

BCCCNP Wrap-Around Grant

As of April 1, 2016 all participating BCCCNP sites have access to serve patients under our Komen grant funding: BCCCNP Wrap-Around Program. The program is intended to fill gaps in service for patients who do not qualify for services under BCCCNP. For example, women under age 40 with a symptom or family history of breast cancer; men with a breast cancer symptom would both qualify for services if they have no insurance coverage and meet BCCCNP income guidelines.
