Free COVID-19 Testing Site to Open in Kalamazoo County

Kalamazoo, MI – Kalamazoo County Health & Community Services Department, in partnership with the Michigan Department of Health and Humans Services, (MDHHS) and the Centers for Disease Control, (CDC) is set to open a new COVID-19 PCR testing location in Kalamazoo County. Curbside, self-administered testing will be available at no out-of-pocket cost and results will be delivered electronically within 2-3 days. The new site will be located at the Kalamazoo County Expo Center, 2900 Lake St, Kalamazoo, MI 49048, and will begin operations on February 11, 2022 at 11:30 am and will end operations on February 28. Appointments are available on weekdays (Mon-Fri) between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.
