KALAMAZOO, Mich. — 2025 Kalamazoo County Park passes make great gifts for the holidays. Take advantage of the special Buy 3 Get 1 Free holiday sale for park passes starting Dec. 1 through Dec. 20. Parks passes are available for \$30 or \$25 for seniors and are valid for the remainder of the year and all next year.

The parks offer many options for outdoor recreation year-round. Check out the sledding hill at Prairie View County Park, go for a hike, try ice fishing, or take your dog to the dog park. When the weather warms up, plan a camping weekend, have a family picnic, enjoy the splash pad, play disc golf, or take your boat out on one of the lakes.

Annual passes give access to all six parks in the Kalamazoo County Parks System: Cold Brook County Park in Climax, Markin Glen County Park just north of Downtown Kalamazoo, Prairie View County Park in Vicksburg, River Oaks County Park in Galesburg, Scotts Mill County Park in Scotts, and the Arthur & Mildred Woollam Nature Preserve in Texas Township.

“We love seeing people use the parks throughout the year, not just during the summer. Ice fishing, walking, sledding, and visiting the dog parks are all popular winter activities at the parks,” said David Rachowicz, Kalamazoo County Parks Director. “The passes make excellent gifts for Christmas, especially for dog park users and families that want to enjoy our Splash Pad at River Oaks next summer.
