Kalamazoo County Announces William Gray as The First Director of Diversity Equity and Inclusion

Scheduled to begin work on Monday March 7

Kalamazoo, MI: — Kalamazoo County Board of Commissioners appointed William (Alvin) Gray as the first Director of Diversity Equity and Inclusion (DEI) on February 9, 2022, during a special meeting of the Board. Gray is scheduled to begin work on Monday, March 7, 2022. The purpose of the DEI Director is to implement the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Strategic Work Plan, develop and manage comprehensive agency-wide DEI programming, and provide guidance to leadership and employees at every level of the organization. This position will provide training, technical expertise, coordination, and guidance for DEI committees and teams to build efficacy and cultural competency across Kalamazoo County Government.
