### **Kalamazoo County Parks now hiring summer Park Attendants at new hourly rate of \$15**

KALAMAZOO, Mich. – Kalamazoo County Parks Department is looking for approximately 40 energetic and enthusiastic Seasonal Park Attendants to join the team this summer at a new wage of \$15 per hour.

Summer positions include a range of duties such as collecting entrance fees and providing information to park visitors, working at the campgrounds and beaches, lawn mowing, and other light maintenance. Seasonal Park Attendants will be scheduled for a variable of 20 to 40 hours per week, including evenings, weekends, and holidays. Positions will start as early as April and last through October, but shorter time frames are available.

“The County Parks attract many visitors throughout the summer,” said Josh Gower, Parks Operations Manager. “These positions offer a lot of variety, and you get to interact with all kinds of people and gain experience performing many different tasks.”

The Kalamazoo County Parks system includes Cold Brook County Park in Climax, Markin Glen County Park just north of downtown Kalamazoo, Prairie View County Park in Vicksburg, River Oaks County Park in Comstock Township, Scotts Mill County Park in Scotts, the Kalamazoo River Valley Trail, the Kalamazoo County Expo Center, and the Kalamazoo County Youth Fair.
